SUPPLEMENTAL BID BULLETIN NO. 4

Tender Documents for the Supply and Delivery of Oil-Based Fuel to NPC, its IPPs and SPUG Power Plants and Barges for CY 2010

All holders of the above document are hereby informed of the changes in the provisions and attachments to the tender documents as follows :

1. **ITB-15, Bid Submission : Eligibility, Technical and Financial Components.** Section ITB 15.1, the first sentence referring to BDS 25.1 shall be revised to BDS 24.
2. **ITB-23, Sealing and Marking of Bids.** Section 23.3 (f), Item f.1. In the first paragraph, the words "For bids with Total Contract Prices worth PhP 300 Million and below" shall be revised to "For power plants/delivery points with Approved Budget for Contract (ABC) worth below PhP 300 Million".

In item f.2, first paragraph, the words "For bids with Total Contract Prices worth more than PhP 300 Million" shall be revised to "For power plants/delivery points with Approved Budget for Contract (ABC) worth PhP 300 Million and above". The first sentence of the second paragraph shall also be revised to read as follows, "The envelope shall contain the Bidder's bid for a specific type of fuel for a particular power plant/delivery point with total contract price worth PhP 300 Million and above or a total contract price that resulted to an amount below PhP 300 Million from an ABC worth PhP 300 Million and above."

3. **SCC-11, Penalty in Oil-Based Fuel Quality.** Section 11.1.b.2. IPP Power Plants/Barges. The provision shall be revised to read as follows, "Fuel deliveries to IPPs below the minimum Low Heating Value (LHV) specification required in NPC's contract with the IPP shall be rejected."
4. **Section VI-A, Table of Delivery Points for Bidding; Section VI-B, Schedule of Monthly Requirements; Section VIII a) Bid Price Proposal Forms; ITB-OBF Form No. 4 – Approved Budget for Contract for Bidding and ITB-OBF Form No. 5 – Bid Security Requirement.**
 - 4.1 **Part I - NPC and IPP Plants Under OMA with PSALM.** The Table of Delivery Points for Bidding, Schedule of Monthly Fuel Requirements and Bid Price Proposal Forms had been revised to reflect the changes in the power plants/delivery points included in the bidding and the quantity for procurement pursuant to Supplemental Bid Bulletin No. 3 dated 11 February 2010.

4.2 Part II - NPC SPUG Power Plants.

- a. The Table of Delivery Points for Bidding, Schedule of Monthly Fuel Requirements, Bid Price Proposal Forms, Approved Budget for Contract and Bid Security Requirement for Cluster Plants 1 to 4 had been revised to reflect changes in the Mode of Delivery and Delivery Points on a "Per Block" and "Per Plant" basis.
- b. Notes K and L of the Bid Price Proposal Forms should reflect ratio of 98% of Product Cost and 2% of Biofuel Cost. Hence, the parameters should be $(0.98 \times \text{Product Cost}) + (0.02 \times \text{Biofuel Cost})$ in the E-VAT and Delivered Price formulas.

5. Section VII – Technical Specifications.

5.1 Part I - NPC and IPP Plants Under OMA with PSALM.

- a. The Industrial Diesel Oil and Industrial Fuel Oil quality specifications for Bohol DP, Panay DP I, Panay DP III, Bataan CCPP, PB-117 and PB-118 shall be deleted.
- b. The Industrial Fuel Oil quality specifications for Malaya TP shall be deleted.
- c. Industrial Fuel Oil deliveries to IPP-Mindanao Power Plants, SPPC and WMPC, with Low Heating Value (LHV) below the minimum limit of 17,216 Btu/lb. shall be subject to Outright Rejection (OR), pursuant to SCC-11.1.b.2.

The deadline for submission of bids (BDS 24) shall be revised from February 22, 2010 to **February 24, 2010 at 9:30 AM** at the **Pahiyas Function Room**, NPC, Diliman, Quezon City.

Attached are the revised forms and attachments which shall be used in the bidding for this requirement.
