F. CLARIFICATION

- a. Supporting documents for SLCC under Section III – Bid Data Sheet Clause 10.4**
"Certificate of Acceptance; or Certificate of Completion; or Official Receipt (O.R); or Sales Invoice"

The amount of contract for the SLCC is not required to be stated in the Certificates of Acceptance or Completion but this should include the project title and contract duration. As for the Official Receipts or Sales Invoice, all must be submitted, not a summary of ORs or SIs.

- b. Submission of updated list of Remittances in the absence of certifications from SSS

NPC will adhere to its requirement that during post qua the bidder must submit Clearance Certificate from Social Security System (updated remittance as of February 2025 or later).

- c. Specific addresses for deployment

NPC will provide the addresses once the contract has been awarded.

- d. Provision of template for the technical forms such as (Omnibus, Undertakings, Bid Securing declaration)

Soft copies of the technical forms may be requested once bid documents has been purchased by the bidder provided that the forms shall not be altered.

- e. Conduct of Security Survey and Security Plan

Bidders are enjoined to conduct security surveys and submission of security plan is not required.

- f. Requirement of Supervisory staff and/or officers

It is not required. However, the winning bidder may opt to deploy supervisory staff and/or officers, without additional cost to NPC.

- g. Basis of computation for SSS Premium and Philhealth Contribution in your Bid Price Computation template

SSS Circular No. 2024-006 (Schedule of SSS contributions effective January 2025) and Philhealth Circular No. 2019-0009 (new premium contribution schedule effective December 7, 2019)

- h. What will happen to bidder/s who will offer below the minimum Agency Fee?

The NPC shall implement Sec. 9 of RA 11917 ("The Private Security Services Industry Act") which requires that the minimum administrative fee that can be charged by the security agency to the procuring entity shall not be less than twenty percent (20%) of the total cost. Failure to comply with the said provision shall be ground for disqualification.

- i. The cost of Uniform that we can bill to the client is just P50.00/month/contracted guard, but per Regulation (RA 5487), it should be P100.00/month.

There is no specific provision in RA 5487 which states that uniform allowance should be PhP 100.00. Thus, NPC will adhere to its requirements of PhP 50.00/month.

- j. Why is that the retirement benefit as per RA 7641 is not included in your Price Computation Template?

Under Republic Act No. 7641, it is the employer who is legally mandated to provide retirement benefits to its employees. In the case of outsourced security

services, the security agency is considered the direct employer of the security guards, not the NPC.

Therefore, as the direct employer, the security agency has the responsibility to comply with RA 7641, including the provision for retirement benefits. These obligations are already inherent in the agency's labor costs and are separate from the service fees charged to the client.
