Minutes of the Proceedings

The Pre-Bid Conference was formally opened at around 09:30 A.M. at the Kañao Function Room by Atty. Rogel T. Teves, BAC Chairman and VP-SPUG, together with the members of BAC, TWG, BCSD Facilitator and participating bidders.
