3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183.

1. Scope of Bid

The National Power Corporation (NPC or NAPOCOR) wishes to receive Bids for the TWO (2) YEARS 500 MBPS OR ABOVE COMMITTED INFORMATION RATE (CIR) INTERNET GATEWAY SERVICE CONECTION FOR NATIONAL POWER CORPORATION, with identification number PR NO. HO-IST25-007.

The Procurement Project (referred to herein as "Project") is composed of one (1) lot and will be awarded to one (1) Bidder in one complete contract, the details of which are described in Section VI (Technical Specifications).

2. Funding Information

- 2.1. The GOP through the source of funding as indicated below for CY 2025 2027 in the amount of **P 1,596,000.00**.
- 2.2. The source of funding is the Corporate Operating Budget of the National Power Corporation.

3. Bidding Requirements

The Bidding for the Project shall be governed by all the provisions of RA No. 9184 and its 2016 revised IRR, including its Generic Procurement Manuals and associated policies, rules and regulations as the primary source thereof, while the herein clauses shall serve as the secondary source thereof.

Any amendments made to the IRR and other GPPB issuances shall be applicable only to the ongoing posting, advertisement, or **IB** by the BAC through the issuance of a supplemental or bid bulletin.

The Bidder, by the act of submitting its Bid, shall be deemed to have verified and accepted the general requirements of this Project, including other factors that may affect the cost, duration and execution or implementation of the contract, project, or work and examine all instructions, forms, terms, and project requirements in the Bidding Documents.

4. Corrupt, Fraudulent, Collusive, and Coercive Practices

The Procuring Entity, as well as the Bidders and Suppliers, shall observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of the contract. They or through an agent shall not engage in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, coercive, and obstructive practices defined under Annex "I" of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 or other integrity violations in competing for the Project.

5. Eligible Bidders

5.1. Only Bids of Bidders found to be legally, technically, and financially capable will be evaluated.



5.2. Foreign ownership exceeding those allowed under the rules may participate when citizens, corporations, or associations of a country, included in the list issued by the GPPB, the laws or regulations of which grant reciprocal rights or privileges to citizens, corporations, or associations of the Philippines.

The foreign bidder claiming eligibility by reason of their country's extension of reciprocal rights to Filipinos shall submit a certification from the relevant government office of their country stating that Filipinos are allowed to participate in their government procurement activities for the same item/product. The said certification shall be validated during the post-qualification of bidders.

- 5.3. Pursuant to Section 23.4.1.3 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No.9184, the Bidder shall have an SLCC that is at least one (1) contract similar to the Project the value of which, adjusted to current prices using the PSA's CPI, must be at least equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC.
- 5.4. The Bidders shall comply with the eligibility criteria under Section 23.4.1 of the 2016 IRR of RA No. 9184.

6. Origin of Goods

There is no restriction on the origin of goods other than those prohibited by a decision of the UN Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the UN, subject to Domestic Preference requirements under **ITB** Clause 18.

7. Subcontracts

7.1. The Bidder may subcontract portions of the Project to the extent allowed by the Procuring Entity as stated herein, but in no case more than twenty percent (20%) of the Project.

The portions of Project and the maximum percentage allowed to be subcontracted are indicated in the **BDS**, which shall not exceed twenty percent (20%) of the contracted Goods.

- 7.2. The Supplier may identify its subcontractor during the contract implementation stage. Subcontractors identified during the bidding may be changed during the implementation of this Contract. Subcontractors must submit the documentary requirements under Section 23.1 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 and comply with the eligibility criteria specified in **ITB** Clause 5 to the implementing or end-user unit.
- 7.3. Subcontracting of any portion of the Project does not relieve the Supplier of any liability or obligation under the Contract. The Supplier will be responsible for the acts, defaults, and negligence of any subcontractor, its agents, servants, or workmen as fully as if these were the Supplier's own acts, defaults, or negligence, or those of its agents, servants, or workmen.

8. Pre-Bid Conference

The Procuring Entity will hold a pre-bid conference for this Project on the specified date and time and either at its physical address and/or through videoconferencing/webcasting as indicated in paragraph 6 of the IB. SECTION II - INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

9. Clarification and Amendment of Bidding Documents

Prospective bidders may request for clarification on and/or interpretation of any part of the Bidding Documents. Such requests must be in writing and received by the Procuring Entity, either at its given address or through electronic mail indicated in the **IB**, at least ten (10) calendar days before the deadline set for the submission and receipt of Bids.

10. Documents comprising the Bid: Eligibility and Technical Components

- 10.1. The first envelope shall contain the eligibility and technical documents of the Bid as specified in Section VIII (NPCSF-GOODS-01 Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents).
- 10.2. The Bidder's SLCC as indicated in **ITB** Clause 5.3 should have been completed within Five (5) Years prior to the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids.
- 10.3. If the eligibility requirements or statements, the bids, and all other documents for submission to the BAC are in foreign language other than English, it must be accompanied by a translation in English, which shall be authenticated by the appropriate Philippine foreign service establishment, post, or the equivalent office having jurisdiction over the foreign bidder's affairs in the Philippines. Similar to the required authentication above, for Contracting Parties to the Apostille Convention, only the translated documents shall be authenticated through an apostille pursuant to GPPB Resolution No. 13-2019 dated 23 May 2019. The English translation shall govern, for purposes of interpretation of the bid.
- 10.4. The Statement of the bidder's Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) (NPCSF-GOODS-03) and List of all Ongoing Government & Private Contracts Including Contracts Awarded but not yet Started (NPCSF-GOODS-02) shall comply with the documentary requirements specified in the <u>BDS.</u>

11. Documents comprising the Bid: Financial Component

- 11.1. The second bid envelope shall contain the financial documents for the Bid as specified in Section VIII (NPCSF-GOODS-01 Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents).
- 11.2. If the Bidder claims preference as a Domestic Bidder or Domestic Entity, a certification issued by DTI shall be provided by the Bidder in accordance with Section 43.1.3 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
 - 11.3. Any bid exceeding the ABC indicated in paragraph 1 of the IB shall not be accepted.
 - 11.4. For Foreign-funded Procurement, a ceiling may be applied to bid prices provided the conditions are met under Section 31.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

12. Bid Prices

- 12.1. Prices indicated on the Price Schedule shall be entered separately in the following manner:
 - a. For Goods offered from within the Procuring Entity's country:



- i. The price of the Goods quoted EXW (ex-works, ex-factory, exwarehouse, ex-showroom, or off-the-shelf, as applicable);
- ii. The cost of all customs duties and sales and other taxes already paid or payable;
- iii. The cost of transportation, insurance, and other costs incidental to delivery of the Goods to their final destination; and
- iv. The price of other (incidental) services, if any, listed in the **BDS**.
- b. For Goods offered from abroad:
 - i. Unless otherwise stated in the **BDS**, the price of the Goods shall be quoted delivered duty paid (DDP) with the place of destination in the Philippines as specified in the **BDS**. In quoting the price, the Bidder shall be free to use transportation through carriers registered in any eligible country. Similarly, the Bidder may obtain insurance services from any eligible source country.
 - ii. The price of other (incidental) services, if any, as listed in the **BDS**.

13. Bid and Payment Currencies

- 13.1. For Goods that the Bidder will supply from outside the Philippines, the bid prices may be quoted in the local currency or tradeable currency accepted by the BSP at the discretion of the Bidder. However, for purposes of bid evaluation, Bids denominated in foreign currencies, shall be converted to Philippine currency based on the exchange rate as published in the BSP reference rate bulletin on the day of the bid opening.
- 13.2. Payment of the contract price shall be made in Philippine Pesos.

14. Bid Security

- 14.1. The Bidder shall submit a Bid Securing Declaration or any form of Bid Security in the amount indicated in the **BDS**, which shall be not less than the percentage of the ABC in accordance with the schedule in the **BDS**.
- 14.2. The Bid and bid security shall be valid for **One Hundred Twenty (120) calendar** days from the date of opening of bids. Any Bid not accompanied by an acceptable bid security shall be rejected by the Procuring Entity as non-responsive.

15. Sealing and Marking of Bids

Each Bidder shall submit Two (2) copies of the first and second components of its Bid, marked **Original** and photocopy. Only the original copy will be read and considered for the bid.

Any misplaced document outside of the **Original** copy will not be considered. The photocopy is <u>ONLY FOR REFERENCE.</u>

The Procuring Entity may request additional hard copies and/or electronic copies of the Bid. However, failure of the Bidders to comply with the said request shall not be a ground for disqualification.

If the Procuring Entity allows the submission of bids through online submission to the given website or any other electronic means, the Bidder shall submit an electronic copy of its Bid, which must be digitally signed. An electronic copy that cannot be opened or is corrupted shall be considered non-responsive and, thus, automatically disqualified.

Bidders must also comply with the Disclaimer and Data Privacy Notice specified in the **BDS**.

16. Deadline for Submission of Bids

16.1. The Bidders shall submit on the specified date and time and either at its physical address or through online submission as indicated in paragraph 7 of the **IB**.

17. Opening and Preliminary Examination of Bids

17.1. The BAC shall open the Bids in public at the time, on the date, and at the place specified in paragraph 9 of the IB. The Bidders' representatives who are present shall sign a register evidencing their attendance. In case videoconferencing, webcasting or other similar technologies will be used, attendance of participants shall likewise be recorded by the BAC Secretariat.

In case the Bids cannot be opened as scheduled due to justifiable reasons, the rescheduling requirements under Section 29 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 shall prevail.

17.2. The preliminary examination of bids shall be governed by Section 30 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

18. Domestic Preference

18.1. The Procuring Entity will grant a margin of preference for the purpose of comparison of Bids in accordance with Section 43.1.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

19. Detailed Evaluation and Comparison of Bids

- 19.1. The Procuring Entity's BAC shall immediately conduct a detailed evaluation of all Bids rated "*passed*," using non-discretionary pass/fail criteria. The BAC shall consider the conditions in the evaluation of Bids under Section 32.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 19.2. If the Project allows partial bids, bidders may submit a proposal on any of the lots or items, and evaluation will be undertaken on a per lot or item basis, as the case maybe. In this case, the Bid Security as required by **ITB** Clause 14 shall be submitted for each lot or item separately.
- 19.3. The descriptions of the lots or items shall be indicated in Section VI (Technical Specifications), although the ABCs of these lots or items are indicated in the <u>BDS</u> for purposes of the NFCC computation pursuant to Section 23.4.2.6 of the

2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184. The NFCC must be sufficient for the total of the ABCs for all the lots or items participated in by the prospective Bidder.

- 19.4. The Project shall be awarded to one (1) Bidder in one complete contract.
- 19.5. Except for bidders submitting a committed Line of Credit from a Universal or Commercial Bank in lieu of its NFCC computation, all Bids must include the NFCC computation pursuant to Section 23.4.1.4 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, which must be sufficient for the total of the ABCs for all the lots or items participated in by the prospective Bidder. For bidders submitting the committed Line of Credit, it must be at least equal to ten percent (10%) of the ABCs for all the lots or items participated in by the prospective Bidder.

20. Post-Qualification

20.1. Within a non-extendible period of five (5) calendar days from receipt by the Bidder of the notice from the BAC that it submitted the Lowest Calculated Bid, the Bidder shall submit its latest income and business tax returns filed and paid through the BIR Electronic Filing and Payment System (eFPS) and other appropriate licenses and permits required by law and stated in the **BDS**.

21. Signing of the Contract

21.1. The documents required in Section 37.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 shall form part of the Contract. Additional Contract documents are indicated in the **BDS**.

All the provisions of RA No. 9184 and its 2016 revised IRR, including the Generic Procurement Manual, and associated issuances, constitute the primary source for the terms and conditions of the Contract, and thus, applicable in contract implementation. Herein clauses shall serve as the secondary source for the terms and conditions of the contract.

This is without prejudice to Sections 74.1 and 74.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 allowing the GPPB to amend the IRR_4 which shall be applied to all procurement activities, the advertisement, posting, or invitation of which were issued after the effectivity of the said amendment.

Additional requirements for the completion of this Contract shall be provided in the **Special Conditions of Contract (SCC).**

2. Advance Payment and Terms of Payment

- 2.1. Advance payment of the contract amount is provided under Annex "D" of the revised 2016 IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 2.2. The Procuring Entity is allowed to determine the terms of payment on the partial or staggered delivery of the Goods procured, provided such partial payment shall correspond to the value of the goods delivered and accepted in accordance with prevailing accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The terms of payment are indicated in the **SCC**.

3. Performance Security

- 3.1. Within ten (10) calendar days from receipt of the Notice of Award by the Bidder from the Procuring Entity but in no case later than the signing of the Contract by both parties, the successful Bidder shall furnish the performance security in any of the forms prescribed in Section 39 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 3.2. The performance bond to be posted by the Contractor must also comply with additional requirements specified in the **SCC**.

4. Inspection and Tests

The Procuring Entity or its representative shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the Goods to confirm their conformity to the Project specifications at no extra cost to the Procuring Entity in accordance with the Generic Procurement Manual. In addition to tests in the **SCC**, **Section VI (Technical Specifications)** shall specify what inspections and/or tests the Procuring Entity requires, and where they are to be conducted. The Procuring Entity shall notify the Supplier in writing, in a timely manner, of the identity of any representatives retained for these purposes. All reasonable facilities and assistance for the inspection and testing of Goods, including access to drawings and production data, shall be provided by the Supplier to the authorized inspectors at no charge to the Procuring Entity.

5. Warranty

- 5.1 In order to assure that manufacturing defects shall be corrected by the Supplier, a warranty shall be required from the Supplier as provided under Section 62.1 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 5.2 The Procuring Entity shall promptly notify the Supplier in writing of any claims arising under this warranty. Upon receipt of such notice, the Supplier shall, repair or replace the defective Goods or parts thereof without cost to the Procuring Entity, pursuant to the Generic Procurement Manual.

6. Liability of the Supplier

The Supplier's liability under this Contract shall be as provided by the laws of the Republic of the Philippines.

If the Supplier is a joint venture, all partners to the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable to the Procuring Entity.

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TS-1.0 GENERAL

This section outlines the technical requirements and expectations for the internet gateway service contract. It serves as a guide for potential service providers to understand the project scope and bidding requirements.

Two (2) years 500 Mbps or above Committed Information Rate (CIR) Internet Gateway Service Connection for the National Power Corporation.

The project mainly consists of provisions for replacing/upgrading the existing internet gateway service contract and providing a redundant connection for high availability.

The existing Service Provider to the <u>National Power Corporation</u>, <u>Gabriel Y. Itchon Building, Senator Miriam P. Defensor-Santiago</u> <u>Avenue, corner Quezon Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City-1100</u>, is due to expire on <u>05 August 2025</u>.

The Service Provider shall refer to the provider, distributor, or reseller of the internet gateway services as specified in this Bid Document.

TS-2.0 SCOPE OF WORKS

The works to be done under this specification and other associated requirements shall generally include the supply, delivery, and installation of the necessary equipment but are not limited to the following:

- 2.1 The Service Provider shall supply, deliver, configure, install, and maintain within the two (2) years service contract the internet gateway and equipment with at least 500 Mbps Committed Information Rate (CIR), symmetrical upload and download for the National Power Corporation Head Office.
- 2.2 A minimum of at least sixty-two (62) Usable Public IP addresses (/26 IP blocks) shall be included in the internet gateway service contract.
- 2.3 Provision of Bandwidth Utilization Reporting Tool.

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- 2.4 State-of-the-art technology with due consideration to scalability, openness, interoperability, high performance, maintainability, and cost-effectiveness.
- 2.5 Installation and termination of fiber optic cables, conduits, and supports must conform to technical requirements.
- 2.6 The technical specifications must indicate or detail explicitly additional components, other works, and services necessary for the system's complete, continuous, and reliable operation.

TS-3.0 CONTRACT PERIOD AND LOCATION

The Internet gateway service contract period shall be two (2) years and shall commence after the expiration on 05 August 2025 of the existing Internet Service Provider with contract number LOG MMSP 2023-07-055-MGF.

All equipment shall be supplied and installed at <u>National Power</u> <u>Corporation, Gabriel Y. Itchon Building, Senator Miriam P. Defensor-</u> <u>Santiago Avenue, corner Quezon Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City-1100.</u>

TS-4.0 MATERIALS

All materials and equipment supplied shall be brand-new, following the applicable governing standards.

Materials and equipment shall be subject to National Power Corporation's quality assurance/inspection. When required by the specification or when requested by National Power Corporation, the Service Provider shall furnish National Power Corporation with complete information concerning the materials, equipment, or articles proposed to be incorporated into the work for approval. Samples shall be submitted for quality assurance and acceptance when National Power Corporation directs.

TS-5.0 DELIVERY PERIOD

The Service Provider shall complete the delivery, installation, configuration, testing, and commissioning of the system to establish the service subject to the agreement within Thirty (30) Calendar Days of receiving the Notice to Proceed from the National Power Corporation.



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TS-6.0 DETAILS OF INTERCONNECTION

500 MBPS (minimum) connection of National Power Corporation Head Office located at Diliman, Quezon City, to the Service Provider's Internet Gateway Hub.

TS-7.0 SERVICE LEVEL AGREEMENT (SLA)

7.1 CUSTOMER CIRCUIT FAILURE NOTIFICATION

The service provider must monitor the connectivity of the customer router every hour. Suppose a router does not respond after two consecutive hourly checks. In that case, the Service Provider must regard it as a possible circuit outage or evidence of insufficient customer bandwidth and undertake to notify the customer immediately and make follow-ups within one (1) hour. Notifications will be sent to the National Power Corporation telephone number or the 24-hour contact number provided by the National Power Corporation.

7.2 SUPPORT

The Service Provider must be capable of providing 24-hour support service and must ensure that calls made to the Support Engineer outside Business Hours are returned within one (1) hour.

7.3 NETWORK QUALITY OF SERVICE

- 7.3.1 The Service Provider must guarantee a 99.5% connection availability. This guarantee excludes problems caused by power disruption at National Power Corporation's premises.
- 7.3.2 The Service Provider must check the installed circuit's bandwidth use every hour. Suppose a course's physical or tiered bandwidth exceeds 90% utilization for more than 20 24 samples. In that case, the Service Provider must notify National Power Corporation within four business hours.
- 7.3.3 The Service Provider must guarantee an average roundtrip latency of not more than 80 milliseconds from the National Power Corporation's Head Office to the ISP port

and not more than 200 milliseconds from the local ISP port to the US/International port.

7.4 MAINTENANCE

The Service Provider shall conduct routine equipment maintenance as stated in the maintenance schedule they submit to National Power Corporation. Maintenance shall include, but not be limited to, checking, calibration, cleaning, and installing eauipment repairs. Durina such time. National Power Corporation recognized the possibility of service interruption not attributable to the Service Provider. National Power Corporation agrees to cooperate with the Service Provider during the maintenance schedule so that the Service Provider may keep downtime to a minimum.

The Service Provider shall provide a monthly report on outages and variances to the Service Level Agreement (SLA).

7.5 SERVICE ESCALATION

The Service Provider must include a Service Escalation Procedure, which includes but is not limited to the following:

- Level 1: Phone call, messaging, and email; resolution must be within 2 hours.
- Lever 2: Phone call, messaging, email, and remote access; resolution must be within 12 hours
- Lever 3: Phone call, messaging, email, remote access, and onsite troubleshooting; resolution must be within 24 hours.

The Service Provider must provide the name, position title, phone number, and email address of contact persons for all levels of the Service Escalation Procedure.

TS-8.0 INTERNET GATEWAY SERVICE CONNECTION

The proposed internet gateway service connection shall be a standalone, completely independent connection. It won't share any physical infrastructure or network paths with the existing NPC internet service lines for redundancy and backup purposes.

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TS-9.0 PENALTY

The Service Provider shall not be held liable for any damages or service interruptions caused by "force majeure" events. These unforeseeable circumstances, such as natural disasters or acts of war, prevent the Service Provider from fulfilling its obligations. Otherwise, circuit outages shall be subjected to the following penalty schedule.

Length of Interruption (minutes)	Penalty
1. less than 30	None
2. 30 ~ 179	1/6 of the contract price per day
3. 180 ~ 359	1/3 of the contract price per day
4. 360 ~ 539	1/2 of the contract price per day
5. 540 ~ 719	5/8 of the contract price per day
6. 720 – 899	7/9 of the contract price per day
7. 900 – 1,440	1 & 1/4 of the contract price per day

Note: Interruptions within a month will be totaled and computed on an accumulated basis.

TS-10.0 TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

National Power Corporation (NPC) shall have the option to terminate the connection before the contract expiration with due notice to be given to the Service Provider.

Failure of the Service Provider to meet SLA commitments for five (5) consecutive days shall be grounds for contract termination.

In the event of the transfer of NPC Head Office to another location, the Service Provider must be able to transfer the services and infrastructure, if available, to the new building location with no additional cost to NPC. NPC can pre-terminate the contract if the Service Provider has no facility or connection to the new building location, subject to three (3) months advance notification.

TS-11.0 WARRANTY

The Service Provider shall provide a warranty to all delivered and installed equipment during the entire duration of the Internet gateway service contract.

To ensure continuity of service, a service unit must be provided to repair pulled-out equipment within the service contract duration.

TS-12.0 ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA

A Certificate of Acceptance shall be issued by the National Power Corporation only after the Service Provider has completed the following activities:

- a) All equipment and devices have been delivered, installed, and properly configured.
- b) All equipment and devices have undergone Power-on self-tests and manufacturer-recommended diagnostic tests, and the Service Provider has submitted the results where applicable.
- c) Applicable integration of components has been set up, and actual testing of appropriate functionalities has been completed.
- d) At least four (4) Information Technology and Services Department (ITSD) personnel shall receive hands-on training on operating and maintaining the internet gateway services.
- e) The Service Provider shall include seven (7) days of transition testing of Bit Error Rate (BER), uploading, downloading, video-conferencing, and browsing free of charge.

TS-13.0 DATA AND DOCUMENTATION

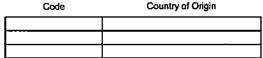
