REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF RENEWABLE ENERGY FOR THE HYBRIDIZATION OF NPC SPUG DIESEL POWER PLANTS UNDER SCHEDULE IV (CLUSTER 10 – TAWI-TAWI)

- 1. The National Power Corporation (NPC), through the Corporate Operating Budget intends to apply the sum of SEVEN HUNDRED FORTY MILLION PESOS (₱740,000,000.00) being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the Supply and Delivery of Renewable Energy for the Hybridization of Diesel Power Plants with Project Identification No. HO-PMD25-004 (PB2). Bids received in excess of the ABC (₱740,000,000.00) or Subsidized Approved Generation Rate (SAGR) of (₱6.7072/kWh) shall be automatically rejected at the opening of the financial proposals.
- 2. The NPC now calls for the submission of eligibility documents for the procurement of services from Renewable Energy Power Producer (REPP) for the Supply and Delivery of Energy for the Hybridization of NPC Diesel Power Plant/s. The REPP will finance, design, construct, operate and maintain its own RE Facility and supply energy/ power to the grid corresponding to area of coverage for a period of twenty (20) years as a supplement or replacement to NPC's diesel genset operation. Eligibility documents of interested bidders must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat on or before 28 April 2025, 9:30 A.M. at the Kañao Function Room, National Power Corporation Head Office Building, Senator Miriam P. Defensor-Santiago Ave. (formerly BIR Road). corner Quezon Ave., Diliman, Quezon City. Applications for eligibility will be evaluated based on a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion.
- 3. Interested bidders may obtain further information from NPC and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during office hours, 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M., Monday to Friday.
- 4. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by the eligible Bidders upon determination of Shortlisted Bidders from the address below and upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of Seventy-Five Thousand Pesos (\$\mathb{P}75,000.00)
 - It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entity, provided that Bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.
- 5. The BAC shall draw up the short list of prospective hidders (pre-qualification stage) from those who have submitted Expression of Interest, including the eligibility documents, and have been determined as eligible in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act", and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR). The short list shall consist of a maximum of seven (7) prospective bidders who will be entitled to submit bids (bidding stage). The criteria and rating system for short listing are:

NOTES:

- 1) In case of tie, the bidders will be ranked from the highest to the lowest contract amount, up to Rank 7. If a tie still exists, a "toss coin" or "draw lots" (for multiple ties) will be used as the tiebreaking method, subject to the provisions of the applicable laws.
- 2) For completed power plant under item 2, the required PSA/PPA shall not be subject of evaluation using the point system.
- Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using the nondiscretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the IRR of RA 9184. Bidding is open to all interested bidders, whether local or foreign, subject to the conditions for eligibility provided in the IRR of RA 9184.
- 7. The NPC shall evaluate bids using the Quality-Cost Based Evaluation/Selection (QCBE/QCBS). The Bidder must meet the minimum technical requirements, the Tariff Rate offer must not exceed the set SAGR, and the computed contract amount shall not exceed the ABC. The criteria and rating system for the evaluation of bids shall be provided in Section 19 of the Instructions to Bidders and Bid Data Sheet. Non-compliance to technical and financial requirements shall be ground for disqualification
- 8. The contract shall be completed within Twenty-Two (22) Years covering the two (2) years pre-construction and construction and twenty (20) years plant operation or upon exhaustion of contract amount whichever is earlier.

- 9. The NPC reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.

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SECTION II - ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENTS

1.0 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 1.1 The following persons/entities shall be allowed to participate in the bidding for the Project:
 - (a) Duly licensed sole proprietorships, partnerships or corporations or cooperatives; or
 - (b) Persons/entities forming themselves into a joint venture, i.e., a group of two
 (2) or more persons/entities that intend to be jointly and severally responsible or liable for a particular contract:
- 1.2. The foreign bidders are eligible to participate in the project bidding subject to the conditions stated in the EDS.
- 1.3. Government owned or controlled corporations (GOCCs) may be eligible to participate only if they can establish that they (a) are legally and financially autonomous, (b) operate under commercial law, and (c) are not attached agencies of the Procuring Entity.

2.0 ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 2.1. The following eligibility requirements, together with the Eligibility Documents Submission Form, shall be submitted on or before the date of the eligibility check specified in the Request for Expression of Interest and Clause 5 for purposes of determining eligibility of prospective bidders:
 - (a) Class "A" Documents -

Legal Documents

(i) PhilGEPS Certificate of Registration and Membership in accordance with Section 8.5.2 of the IRR, except for foreign bidders participating in the procurement by a Philippine Foreign Service Office or Post, which shall submit their eligibility documents under Section 24.1 of the IRR, provided, that the winning bidder shall register with PhilGEPS in accordance with Section 37.1.4 of the IRR;

Technical Documents

- (ii) Statement of the prospective bidder specifying its nationality and confirming that those who will actually perform the service are registered professionals authorized by the appropriate regulatory body to practice those professions and allied professions in accordance with Clause 1.2, including their respective curriculum vitae.
- (iii) Statement of the prospective bidders Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) similar to the contract to be bid.

Contracts similar to the Project shall comply with at least 50% of the ABC either through any of the following:

- Completed PSA/ PPA with contract amount of at least 50% of the ABC
- Completed Construction of Any Power Plant (with ongoing PSA/ PPA) with contract amount of at least 50% of the ABC
- 3. Combination of two (2) similar contracts with an aggregate contract amount of at least 50% of the ABC as follows:
 - 3.1. One (1) completed PSA/ PPA or Completed Construction of Any Power Plant Contract (with ongoing PSA/ PPA) with an amount of at least 25% of the ABC:

and

- 3.2. One (1) ongoing contract (PSA/ PPA of RE Facility only) with completed portion amounting to at least 25% of the ABC, provided that the RE facility is operationalized, and a certificate of satisfactory performance has been issued by the concerned Procuring Entity.
- (b) Class "B" Document -

If applicable, the Joint Venture Agreement (JVA) in case the joint venture is already in existence, or duly notarized statements from all the potential joint venture partners in accordance with Section 24.1(b) of the IRR of RA 9184.

- 2.2. The eligibility requirements or statements, the bids, and all other documents to be submitted to the BAC must be in English. If the eligibility requirements or statements, the bids, and all other documents submitted to the BAC are in foreign language other than English, it must be accompanied by a translation of the documents in English. The documents shall be translated by the relevant foreign government agency, the foreign government agency authorized to translate documents, or a registered translator in the foreign bidder's country; and shall be authenticated by the appropriate Philippine foreign service establishment/post or the equivalent office having jurisdiction over the foreign bidder's affairs in the Philippines. The English translation shall govern, for purposes of interpretation of the bid.
- 2.3. Prospective bidders may obtain a full range of expertise by associating with individual bidder(s) and/or other bidders or entities through a JV, as appropriate.

3. FORMAT AND SIGNING OF ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENTS

- 3.1. Prospective bidders shall submit their eligibility documents through their duly authorized representative on or before the deadline specified in Clause 5.
- 3.2. Prospective bidders shall prepare an original and copies of the eligibility documents. In the event of any discrepancy between the original and the copies, the original shall prevail.

- The Eligibility Documents Submission Form shall be signed by the duly 3.3. authorized representative/s of the Bidder. Failure to do so shall be a ground for the rejection of the eligibility documents.
- Any interlineations, erasures, or overwriting shall be valid only if they are signed 3.4. or initialed by the duly authorized representative/s of the prospective bidder.

SEALING AND MARKING OF ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENTS 4.

- Prospective bidders shall enclose their original eligibility documents described 4.1. in Clause 2.1, in a sealed envelope marked "ORIGINAL - ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENTS". Each copy thereof shall be similarly sealed duly marking the envelopes as "COPY NO. ___ - ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENTS". These envelopes containing the original and the copies shall then be enclosed in one single envelope.
- The original and the number of copies of the eligibility documents as indicated 4.2. in the EDS shall be typed or written in ink and shall be signed by the prospective bidder or its duly authorized representative/s.
- 4.3. All envelopes shall:
 - (a) contain the name of the contract to be bid in capital letters;
 - (b) bear the name and address of the prospective bidder in capital letters;
 - (c) be addressed to the BAC;
 - (d) bear the specific identification of this project indicated in the IAEB; and
 - (e) bear a warning "DO NOT OPEN BEFORE ... " the date and time for the opening of Eligibility Documents indicated in the IAEB, in accordance with Clause 5.
- Eligibility documents that are not properly sealed and marked, as required in 4.4 the bidding documents, shall not be rejected, but the bidder or its duly authorized representative shall acknowledge such condition of the documents as submitted. The BAC shall assume no responsibility for the misplacement of the contents of the improperly sealed or marked eligibility documents, or for its premature opening.

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENTS 5.

Eligibility documents must be received by the Procuring Entity's BAC at the address and on or before the date and time indicated in the Request for Expression of Interest and the EDS.

LATE SUBMISSION OF ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENTS 6.

Any eligibility documents submitted after the deadline for submission and receipt prescribed in Clause 5 shall be declared "Late" and shall not be accepted by the Procuring Entity. The BAC shall record in the minutes of submission and opening of eligibility documents, the Bidder's name, its representative and the time the eligibility documents were submitted late.

SECTION II - ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENTS

7. MODIFICATION AND WITHDRAWAL OF ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENTS

- The prospective bidder may modify its eligibility documents after it has been 7.1. submitted; provided that the modification is received by the Procuring Entity prior to the deadline specified in Clause 5. The prospective bidder shall not be allowed to retrieve its original eligibility documents, but shall be allowed to submit another set equally sealed, properly identified, linked to its original bid marked as "ELIGIBILITY MODIFICATION" and stamped "received" by the BAC. Modifications received after the applicable deadline shall not be considered and shall be returned to the prospective bidder unopened.
- A prospective bidder may, through a letter of withdrawal, withdraw its eligibility 7.2. documents after it has been submitted, for valid and justifiable reason; provided that the letter of withdrawal is received by the Procuring Entity prior to the deadline prescribed for submission and receipt of eligibility documents.
- Eligibility documents requested to be withdrawn in accordance with this Clause 7.3. shall be returned unopened to the prospective bidder concerned. A prospective bidder that withdraws its eligibility documents shall not be permitted to submit another set, directly or indirectly, for the same project. A prospective bidder that acquired the eligibility documents may also express its intention not to participate in the bidding through a letter which should reach and be stamped by the BAC before the deadline for submission and receipt of eligibility documents.

OPENING AND PRELIMINARY EXAMINATION OF ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENTS 8.

The BAC will open the envelopes containing the eligibility documents in the 8.1. presence of the prospective bidders' representatives who choose to attend, at the time, on the date, and at the place specified in the EDS. The prospective bidders' representatives who are present shall sign a register evidencing their attendance.

In case the submitted eligibility envelopes cannot be opened as scheduled due to justifiable reasons, the BAC shall take custody of the said envelopes and reschedule the opening on the next working day or at the soonest possible time through the issuance of a Notice of Postponement to be posted in the PhilGEPS website and the website of the Procuring Entity concerned.

- 8.2. Letters of withdrawal shall be read out and recorded during the opening of eligibility documents and the envelope containing the corresponding withdrawn eligibility documents shall be returned unopened to the withdrawing prospective bidder.
- 8.3. The eligibility documents envelopes and modifications, if any, shall be opened one at a time, and the following read out and recorded:
 - (a) the name of the prospective bidder;
 - (b) whether there is a modification or substitution; and
 - (c) the presence or absence of each document comprising the eligibility documents vis-à-vis a checklist of the required documents.

The eligibility of each prospective bidder shall be determined by examining each 8.4. bidder's eligibility requirements or statements against a checklist of requirements, using non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion, as stated in the Request for Expression of Interest, and shall be determined as either "eligible" or "ineligible." If a prospective bidder submits the specific eligibility document required, he shall be rated "passed" for that particular requirement. In this regard, failure to submit a requirement, or an incomplete or patently insufficient submission, shall be considered "failed" for the particular eligibility requirement concerned. If a prospective bidder is rated "passed" for all the eligibility requirements, he shall be considered eligible to participate in the bidding, and the BAC shall mark the set of eligibility documents of the prospective bidder concerned as "eligible." If a prospective bidder is rated "failed" in any of the eligibility requirements, he shall be considered ineligible to participate in the bidding, and the BAC shall mark the set of eligibility documents of the prospective bidder concerned as "ineligible." In either case, the BAC chairperson or his duly designated authority shall countersign the markings.

SHORT LISTINGS OF PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS 9.

- Only prospective bidders whose submitted contracts are similar in nature and 9.1. complexity to the contract to be bid as provided in the EDS shall be considered for short listing.
- The BAC shall draw up the short list of prospective bidders from those declared 9.2. eligible using the detailed set of criteria and rating system to be used specified in the EDS.
- Shortlisted prospective bidders shall be invited to participate in the bidding for 9.3. this project through a Notice of Eligibility and Short Listing issued by the BAC.

10. PROTEST MECHANISM

Decision of the Procuring Entity at any stage of the procurement process may be guestioned in accordance with Section 55 of the IRR of RA 9184.
