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Glossary of Acronyms, Terms, and Abbreviations

ABC-Approved Budget for the Contract.

BAC - Bids and Awards Committee.

Bid – A signed offer or proposal to undertake a contract submitted by a bidder in response to and in consonance with the requirements of the bidding documents. Also referred to as *Proposal* and *Tender*. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[c])

Bidder – Refers to a contractor, manufacturer, supplier, distributor and/or consultant who submits a bid in response to the requirements of the Bidding Documents. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[d])

Bidding Documents – The documents issued by the Procuring Entity as the bases for bids, furnishing all information necessary for a prospective bidder to prepare a bid for the Goods, Infrastructure Projects, and/or Consulting Services required by the Procuring Entity. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[e])

BIR - Bureau of Internal Revenue.

BSP - BangkoSentralngPilipinas.

Consulting Services – Refer to services for Infrastructure Projects and other types of projects or activities of the GOP requiring adequate external technical and professional expertise that are beyond the capability and/or capacity of the GOP to undertake such as, but not limited to: (i) advisory and review services; (ii) pre-investment or feasibility studies; (iii) design; (iv) construction supervision; (v) management and related services; and (vi) other technical services or special studies. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[i])

CDA - Cooperative Development Authority,

Contract—Refers to the agreement entered into between the Procuring Entity and the Supplier or Manufacturer or Distributor or Service Provider for procurement of Goods and Services; Contractor for Procurement of Infrastructure Projects; or Consultant or Consulting Firm for Procurement of Consulting Services; as the case may be, as recorded in the Contract Form signed by the parties, including all attachments and appendices thereto and all documents incorporated by reference therein.

DDP - Refers to the quoted price of the Goods, which means "delivered duty paid."

Framework Agreement – Refers to a written agreement between a procuring entity and a supplier or service provider that identifies the terms and conditions, under which specific purchases, otherwise known as "Call-Offs," are made for the duration of the agreement. It is in the nature of an option contract between the procuring entity and the bidder(s) granting the procuring entity the option to either place an order for any of the goods or services identified in the Framework Agreement List or not buy at all, within a minimum period of one (1) year to a maximum period of three (3) years (GPPB Resolution No. 27:2019)

GFI - Government Financial Institution.

GOCC -Government-ownedland/or -controlled corporation

Goods—Refer to all items, supplies, materials and general support services, except Consulting Services and Infrastructure Projects, which may be needed in the transaction of public businesses or in the pursuit of any government undertaking, project or activity, whether in the nature of equipment, furniture, stationers, materials for construction, or personal property of any kind, including non-personal or contractual services such as the repair and maintenance of equipment and furniture, as well as tracking, hauling, janitorial, security, and related or analogous services, as well as procurement of materials and supplies provided by the Procuring Entity for such services. The term "related" or "analogous services" shall include, but is not limited to, lease or purchase of office space, media advertisements, health maintenance services, and other services essential to the operation of the Procuring Entity. - The NATIONAL POWER CORPORATION—MINDANAO GENERATION, through the CORPORATE BUDGET OF NPC intends to apply the sum of Two Million Nine Hundred Thousand Pesos (PHP2,900,000.00) only being the ABC to payments under the contract for PR. No.MG-A7T24-010-. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
- 2. The NATIONAL POWER CORPORATION—MINDANAO GENERATION now invites bids for the above Procurement Project. Delivery of the Goods is required Sixty (60) Calendar Days from the receipt of Notice to Proceed. Bidders should have completed, within the last five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).
- Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a nondiscretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.
 - Bidding is open to all interested bidders, whether local or foreign, subject to the conditions for eligibility provided in the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
- Prospective Bidders may obtain further information from NATIONAL POWER CORPORATION MINDANAO GENERATION and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during 8:00 AM 5:00 PM, Monday to Friday.
- 5. - Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat through manual submission at the

- 8. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in ITB Clause 14.
- 9. Bid opening shall be on <u>14 December 2023</u>, <u>9:30AM</u> at Bidding Room, Mindanao Generation Headquarters, Maria Cristina, Iligan City. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend the activity.
- 10. The project requires the following major features and specifications of the Agus 6&7 HPPC Redundant Internet Connectivity:
 - a. Installation & laying of two (2) line fiber optic backbone from the ISP's last mile to Agus 6&7 HPPC Main Distribution Service Location Area
 - One (1) line for Agus 6 HPP
 - One (1) line for Agus 7 HPP
 - b. Installation & Configuration of Redundant Internet Connectivity with a bandwidth utilization rate of at least 150 Mbps Downstream & at least 150 Mbps Upstream or 1:1 ratio between Bandwidth and Committed Information Rate (CIR)
 - c. Installation and Configuration of two (2) units Unified Threat Management (UTM) Appliance, Bandwidth & Firewall Manager
 - One (1) line for Agus 6 HPP
 - One (1) line for Agus 7 HPP
 - d. Provision of Multi-Router Traffic Grapher (MRTG) Account
 - e. Provision of NPC- Agus 6&7 Internet Backbone Gateway:

May be detected in case the ABC is less than One Million Pesos (PhP1,000,000) where the Procuring Entity may not hold a Pre-Bid Conference.

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- Bundled service for internet access and related communication uplink & downlink from Tier-One ISP with Wide Area Communication Link support for Multi-protocol applications
- Free provision of at least one Class C block of 29 IP addresses (minimum)
- Waiver of One-time installation charges, One Month deposit, including provision of IP routing service through the alternate/back-up gateway provided by another ISP.
- Free service support in the configuration of NPC- Agus 6&7 HPPC gateway utilizing the entire contracted bandwidth
- Should have a metro-ethernet or domestic ATM core with a minimum bandwidth of STM-4 on the metro layer. Also, there should be a complete layer 1 and 2 redundancy
- The metro-ethernet or equivalent ATM core should be based on carrier-class ATM switches with a minimum 10 Gbps switching capacity.
- The ISP must have at least 1 x STM-16 internet backbone to the US and must provide online live Muti Router Traffic Grapher (MRTG) of the link to NPC- Agus 6&7 HPPC for monitoring and verification of bandwidth.
- The ISP must have at least 2 x STM-4 internet backbone connecting to major Asian countries to major Asian countries for Asia traffic and must provide a live MRTG of the link to NPC- Agus 6&7 HPPC
- The ISP must be able to guarantee latency of less than 250ms at 50% load from NPC-Agus 6&7 HPPC's router to the internet core in the US
- The iSP should include at least six (6) portable internet access anywhere for network monitoring and administrative purposes. Facility/ device should be installed on Tablet/Laptop/Notebook PC.
- The ISP must provide contact information for trouble escalation and 24/7 Help-desk for technical support
- The ISP must provide SLA for all devices and 4 hours physical response time for reported problems
- The link must be successfully "Bit Error Rate" (BER) tested and fully operational. Consequently, can provide 24 hours BER test anytime when required.
- Provision of access to ISP website with continuous graphical gateway bandwidth utilization information for fiber optic line, such as MTRG graphs.

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- · Provision of for rebate in service fees in the event of service interruption for a minimum duration of 2 hours or more in a single day which is not due to failure in NPC- Agus 6&7 HPP's internal network or equipment.
- The ISP should provide a separate fiber optic backbone connection. from the existing NPC- Mingen HQ's and Agus 4&5 HPP.
- The ISP must provide a network plan showing the data connectivity. from Agus 6&7 HPPC to the nearest ISP local exchange to internet gateway
- Contract duration of One (1) year upon start of service and may be extended subject to agreement by both parties
- Brochure is required for product specifications of bundled items
- Warranty of Two (2) year reckoned from the date of final acceptance.
- After-sales support on equipment for Two (2) years after the warranty period
- Delivery/ completion date of Sixty (60) calendar days reckoned from the date of effectivity indicated in the Notice to Proceed (NTP)
- The existing NPC-MinGen HQ ISP's (PLDT/SMART & GLOBE INNOVE, which are also the main internet connection of AGUS 6&7 HPPC). The required redundancy connection offered by prospective bidders must be independent relative to the existing connection. (Redundancy means diverse carrier, different medium and different network connection).

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

Section II



1. Scope of Bid

The Procuring Entity, NATIONAL POWER CORPORATION – MINDANAO GENERATION wishes to receive Bids for the Redundant Internet Connectivity of Agus 6&7 HPPC with identification number MG-A7T24-010.

The Procurement Project (referred to herein as "Project") is composed of *One (1) lot*, the details of which are described in Section VII (Technical Specifications).

2. Funding Information

- 2.1. The GOP through the source of funding as indicated below for 2024 Budget in the amount of Two Million Nine Hundred Thousand Pesos only (PHP2,900,000.00).
- 2,2. The source of funding is:

GOCC and GFIs, the proposed Corporate Operating Budget.

3. Bidding Requirements

The Bidding for the Project shall be governed by all the provisions of RA No. 9184 and its 2016 revised RR, including its Generic Procurement Manuals and associated policies, rules and regulations as the primary source thereof, while the herein clauses shall serve as the secondary source thereof.

Any amendments made to the IRR and other GPPB issuances shall be applicable only to the ongoing posting, advertisement, or IB by the BAC through the issuance of a supplemental or bid bulletin.

The Bidder, by the act of submitting its Bid, shall be deemed to have verified and accepted the general requirements of this Project, including other factors that may affect the cost, duration and execution or implementation of the contract, project, or work and examine all instructions, forms, terms, and project requirements in the Bidding Documents.

4. Corrupt, Fraudulent, Collusive, and Coercive Practices

The Procuring Entity, as well as the Bidders and Suppliers, shall observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of the contract. They or through an agent shall not engage in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, coercive, and obstructive practices defined under Annex "I" of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 or other integrity violations in competing for the Project.

5. Eligible Bidders

- 5.1. Only Bids of Bidders found to be legally, technically, and financially capable will be evaluated.
- 5.2. Foreign ownership limited to those allowed under the rules may participate in this Project.
- 5.3. Pursuant to Section 23.4.1.3 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No.9184, the Bidder shall have an SLCC that is at least one (1) contract similar to the Project the value of which, adjusted to current prices using the PSA's CPI, must be at least equivalent to:

For the procurement of Non-expendable Supplies and Services: The Bidder must have completed a single contract that is similar to this Project, equivalent to at least lifty percent (50%) of the ABC.

5.4. The Bidders shall comply with the eligibility criteria under Section 23.4.1 of the 2016 IRR of RA No. 9184.

6. Origin of Goods

There is no restriction on the origin of goods other than those prohibited by a decision of the UN Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the UN, subject to Domestic Preference requirements under ITB Clause 18.

7. Subcontracts

7.1. The Bidder may subcontract portions of the Project to the extent allowed by the Procuring Entity as stated ferein, but in no case more than twenty percent (20%) of the Project.

The Procuring Entity has prescribed that:

a. Subcontracting is not allowed.

8. Pre-Bid Conference

The Procuring Entity will hold a pre-bid conference for this Project on the specified date and time and either at its physical address and/or through videoconferencing/webcasting} as indicated in paragraph 6 of the IB.

9. Clarification and Amendment of Bidding Documents

Prospective bidders may request for clarification on and/or interpretation of any part of the Bidding Documents. Such requests must be in writing and received by the Procuring Entity, either at its given address or through electronic mail indicated in the

IB, at least ten (10) calendar days before the deadline set for the submission and receipt of Bids.

10. Documents comprising the Bid: Eligibility and Technical Components

- 10.1. The first envelope shall contain the eligibility and technical documents of the Bid as specified in Section VIII (Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents).
- 10.2. The Bidder's SLCC as indicated in ITB Clause 5.3 should have been completed within the last five (5) years prior to the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids.
- 10.3. If the eligibility requirements or statements, the bids, and all other documents for submission to the BAC are in foreign language other than English, it must be accompanied by a translation in English, which shall be authenticated by the appropriate Philippine foreign service establishment, post, or the equivalent office having jurisdiction over the foreign bidder's affairs in the Philippines. Similar to the required authentication above, for Contracting Parties to the Apostille Convention, only the translated documents shall be authenticated through an Apostille pursuant to GPPB Resolution No. 13-2019 dated 23 May 2019. The English translation shall govern, for purposes of interpretation of the bid.

11. Documents comprising the Bid: Financial Component

- 11.1. The second bid envelope shall contain the financial documents for the Bid as specified in Section VIII (Checklistof Technical and Financial Documents).
- 11.2. If the Bidder claims preference as a Domestic Bidder or Domestic Entity, a certification issued by Dill shall be provided by the Bidder in accordance with Section 43.1.3 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 11.3. Any bid exceeding the ABC indicated in paragraph 1 of the IB shall not be accepted.
- For Foreign-funded Procurement, a ceiling may be applied to bid prices provided the conditions are met under Section 31.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

12. Bid Prices

- 12.1. Prices indicated on the Price Schedule shall be entered separately in the following manner:
 - a. For Goods offered from within the Procuring Entity's country:

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- i. The price of the Goods quoted EXW (ex-works, ex-factory, exwarehouse, ex-showroom, or off-the-shelf, as applicable);
- ii. The cost of all customs duties and sales and other taxes already paid or payable;
- iii. The cost of transportation, insurance, and other costs incidental to delivery of the Goods to their final destination; and
- iv. The price of other (incidental) services, if any, listed in e.

For Goods offered from abroad:

- i. Unless otherwise stated in the BDS, the price of the Goods shall be quoted delivered duty paid (DDP) with the place of destination in the Philippines as specified in the BDS. In quoting the price, the Bidder shall be free to use transportation through carriers registered in any eligible country. Similarly, the Bidder may obtain insurance services from any eligible source country.
- The price of other (incidental) services, if any, as listed in Section VII (Technical Specifications).

13. Bid and Payment Currencies

- 13.1. For Goods that the Bidder will supply from outside the Philippines, the bid prices may be quoted in the local currency or tradeable currency accepted by the BSP at the discretion of the Bidder. However, for purposes of bid evaluation, Bids denominated in foreign currencies, shall be converted to Philippine currency based on the exchange rate as published in the BSP reference rate bulletin on the day of the bid opening.
- 13.2. Payment of the contract price shall be made in:
 - a. Philippine Pesos.

14. Bid Security

- 14.1. The Bidder shall submit a Bid Securing Declaration² or any form of Bid Security in the amount indicated in the BDS, which shall be not less than the percentage of the ABC in accordance with the schedule in the BDS.
- 14.2. The Bid and bid security shall be valid until <u>One Hundred Twenty (120) Days</u> from the <u>Date of Scheduled Bid Opening</u>. Any Bid not accompanied by an

² In the case of Framework Agreement, the undertaking shall refer to entering into contract with the Procuring Entity and furnishing of the performance security or the performance securing declaration within ten (10) calendar days from receipt of Notice to Execute Framework Agreement.

acceptable bid security shall be rejected by the Procuring Entity as non-responsive.

15. Scaling and Marking of Bids

Each Bidder shall submit one copy of the first and second components of its Bid.

The Procuring Entity may request additional hard copies and/or electronic copies of the Bid. However, failure of the Bidders to comply with the said request shall not be a ground for disqualification.

If the Procuring Entity allows the submission of bids through online submission or any other electronic means, the Bidder shall submit an electronic copy of its Bid,

which must be digitally signed. An electronic copy that cannot be opened or is corrupted shall be considered non-responsive and, thus, automatically disqualified.

16. Deadline for Submission of Bids

16.1. The Bidders shall submit on the specified date and time and either at its physical address or through online submission as indicated in paragraph F of the IB.

17. Opening and Preliminary Examination of Bids 💛 🦯

17.1. The BAC shall open the Bids in public at the time, on the date, and at the place specified in paragraph 9 of the IB. The Bidders' representatives who are present shall sign a register evidencing their attendance. In case videoconferencing, webcasting or other similar technologies will be used, attendance of participants shall likewise be recorded by the BAC Secretariat.

In case the Bids cannot be opened as scheduled due to justifiable reasons, the rescheduling requirements under Section 29 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 shall prevail.

17.2. The preliminary examination of bids shall be governed by Section 30 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

18. Domestic Preference

18.1. The Procuring Entity will grant a margin of preference for the purpose of comparison of Bids in accordance with Section 43.1.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

19. Detailed Evaluation and Comparison of Bids

19.1. The Procuring BAC shall immediately conduct a detailed evaluation of all Bids rated "passed," using non-discretionary pass/fail criteria. The BAC shall

- consider the conditions in the evaluation of Bids under Section 32.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 19.2. If the Project allows partial bids, bidders may submit a proposal on any of the lots or items, and evaluation will be undertaken on a per lot or item basis, as the case may be. In this case, the Bid Security as required by ITB Clause 15 shall be submitted for each lot or item separately.
- 19.3. The descriptions of the lots or items shall be indicated in Section VII (Technical Specifications), although the ABCs of these lots or items are indicated in the BDS for purposes of the NPCC computation pursuant to Section 23.4.2.6 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184. The NFCC must be sufficient for the total of the ABCs for all the lots or items participated in by the prospective Bidder.
- 19.4. The Project shall be awarded as follows:
 - One Project having several items that shall be awarded as one contract.
- 19.5. Except for bidders submitting a committed Line of Credit from a Universal or Commercial Bank in lieu of its NECC computation, all Bids must include the NFCC computation pursuant to Section 23.4.1.4 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, which must be sufficient for the total of the ABCs for all the lots or items participated in by the prospective Bidder. For bidders submitting the committed Line of Credit, it must be at least equal to ten percent (10%) of the ABCs for all the lots or items participated in by the prospective Bidder.

20. Post-Qualification

- 20.1. For multi-year Framework Agreement, all bidders initially determined to be eligible and financially compliant shall be subject to initial post-qualification. The BAC shall then recommend the execution of a Framework Agreement among all eligible, technically and financially compliant bidders and the Procuring Entity and shall be issued by HoPE a Notice to Execute Framework Agreement. The determination of the Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB) shall not be performed by the BAC until a Mini-Competition is conducted among the bidders who executed a Framework Agreement. When a Call for Mini-Competition is made, the BAC shall allow the bidders to submit their best financial proposals on such pre-scheduled date, time and place to determine the bidder with the LCB.
- 20.2. Within a non-extendible period of five (5) calendar days from receipt by the Bidder of the notice from the BAC that it submitted the Lowest Calculated Bid, the Bidder shall submit its latest income and business tax returns filed and paid through the BIR Electronic Filing and Payment System (cFPS) and other appropriate licenses and permits required by law and stated in the BDS.

21. Signing of the Contract

21.1. The documents required in Section 37.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 shall form part of the Contract. Additional Contract documents are indicated in the BDS.



i. Philippine Bidding Poeuments (PBDs); i. Schedule of Requirements; ii. Rechnical Specifications; iii. General and Special Conditions of Contract; and iv. Supplemental or Bid Bulletins, if any
 Winning bidder's bid, including the Eligibility requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents or statements submitted;
Bid form, including all the documents/statements contained in the Bidder's bidding envelopes, as annexes, and all other documents submitted (e.g., Bidder's respons to request for clarifications on the bid), including corrections to the bid, if any resulting from the Procuring Entity's bid evaluation;
iii. Performance Security;
iv. Notice of Award of Contract; and the Bidder's conforme thereto; and

v. Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Procuring Entity concerned in the PBDs. Winning bidder agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.
