Bid – A signed offer or proposal to undertake a contract submitted by a bidder in response to and in consonance with the requirements of the bidding documents. Also referred to as Proposal and Tender. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[c])

Bidder – Refers to a contractor, manufacturer, supplier, distributor and/or consultant who submits a bid in response to the requirements of the Bidding Documents. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[d])

Bidding Documents – The documents issued by the Procuring Entity as the bases for bids, furnishing all information necessary for a prospective bidder to prepare a bid for the Goods, Infrastructure Projects, and/or Consulting Services required by the Procuring Entity. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[e])

BIR - Bureau of Internal Revenue.

BSP – BangkoSentralngPilipinas.

CDA - Cooperative Development Authority.

Consulting Services – Refer to services for Infrastructure Projects and other types of projects or activities of the GOP requiring adequate external technical and professional expertise that are beyond the capability and/or capacity of the GOP to undertake such as, but not limited to: (i) advisory and review services; (ii) pre-investment or feasibility studies; (iii) design; (iv) construction supervision; (v) management and related services; and (vi) other technical services or special studies, (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[i])

Contract – Refers to the agreement entered into between the Procuring Entity and the Supplier or Manufacturer or Distributor or Service Provider for procurement of Goods and Services; Contractor for Procurement of Infrastructure Projects; or Consultant or Consulting Firm for Procurement of Consulting Services; as the case may be, as recorded in the Contract Form signed by the parties, including all attachments and appendices thereto and all documents incorporated by reference therein.

Contractor – is a natural or juridical entity whose proposal was accepted by the Procuring Entity and to whom the Contract to execute the Work was awarded. Contractor as used in these Bidding Documents may likewise refer to a supplier, distributor, manufacturer, or consultant,

The term "related" or "analogous services" shall include, but is not limited to, lease or purchase of office space, media advertisements, health maintenance services, and other services essential to the operation of the Procuring Entity. - The NATIONAL POWER CORPORATION—MINDANAO GENERATION, through the approved Corporate Budget of NPC for CY 2023 intends to apply the sum of Three Million One Hundred Ninety Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Four & 38/100 Pesos (PHP3,199,994.38) being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for Construction of Multi-Purpose Gymnasium at Taraka, Lanao Del Sur Mitigation and CSR Project (INFRA2023-CDD-009). Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
- The NATIONAL POWER CORPORATION-MINDANAO GENERATION now invites bids for the above Procurement Project. Completion of the Works is required One Hundred Fifteen (115) calendar days. Bidders should have completed a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).
- 3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.

1. Scope of Bid

The Procuring Entity, NATIONAL POWER CORPORATION—MINDANAO GENERATION invites Bids for the CONSTRUCTION OF MULTI-PURPOSE GYMNASIUM AT TARAKA, LANAO DEL SUR, with Project Identification Number INFRA2023-CDD-009.

The Procurement Project (referred to herein as "Project") is for the construction of Works, as described in Section VI (Specifications).

2. Funding Information

- 2.1. The GOP through the source of funding as indicated below for CY 2023 in the amount of *Three Million Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (PHP3,200,000.00)*
- 2.2. The source of funding is:
 - a. GOCC and GFIs, the proposed Corporate Operating Budget.

3. Bidding Requirements

The Bidding for the Project shall be governed by all the provisions of RA No. 9184 and its 2016 revised IRR, including its Generic Procurement Manual and associated policies, rules and regulations as the primary source thereof, while the herein clauses shall serve as the secondary source thereof.

Any amendments made to the IRR and other GPPB issuances shall be applicable only to the ongoing posting, advertisement, or invitation to bid by the BAC through the issuance of a supplemental or bid bulletin.

The Bidder, by the act of submitting its Bid, shall be deemed to have inspected the site, determined the general characteristics of the contracted Works and the conditions for this Project, such as the location and the nature of the work; (b) climatic conditions; (c) transportation facilities; (c) nature and condition of the terrain, geological conditions at the site communication facilities, requirements, location and availability of construction aggregates and other materials, labor, water, electric power and access roads; and (d) other factors that may affect the cost, duration and execution or implementation of the contract, project, or work and examine all instructions, forms, terms, and project requirements in the Bidding Documents.

4. Corrupt, Fraudulent, Collusive, Coercive, and Obstructive Practices

The Procuring Entity, as well as the Bidders and Contractors, shall observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of the contract. They or through an agent shall not engage in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, coercive, and obstructive practices defined under Annex "I" of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 or other integrity violations in competing for the Project.

5. Eligible Bidders

- Only Bids of Bidders found to be legally, technically, and financially capable 5.1. will be evaluated.
- The Bidder must have an experience of having completed a Single Largest 5.2. Completed Contract (SLCC) that is similar to this Project, equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC adjusted, if necessary, by the Bidder to current prices using the PSA's CPI, except under conditions provided for in Section 23.4.2.4 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

A contract is considered to be "similar" to the contract to be bid if it has the major categories of work stated in the BDS.

- For Foreign-funded Procurement, the Procuring Entity and the foreign 5.3. government/foreign or international financing institution may agree on another track record requirement, as specified in the Bidding Document prepared for this purpose.
- 5.4. The Bidders shall comply with the eligibility criteria under Section 23.4.2 of the 2016 IRR of RA No. 9184.

6. Origin of Associated Goods

There is no restriction on the origin of Goods other than those prohibited by a decision of the UN Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the UN.

7. Subcontracts

The Bidder may subcontract portions of the Project to the extent allowed by 7.1. the Procuring Entity as stated herein, but in no case more than fifty percent (50%) of the Project.

The Procuring Entity has prescribed that:

Subcontracting is not allowed.

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8. Pre-Bid Conference

The Procuring Entity will hold a pre-bid conference for this Project on the specified date and time and either at its physical address and/or through videoconferencing/webcasting as indicated in paragraph 6 of the IB.

9. Clarification and Amendment of Bidding Documents

Prospective bidders may request for clarification on and/or interpretation of any part of the Bidding Documents. Such requests must be in writing and received by the Procuring Entity, either at its given address or through electronic mail indicated in the IB, at least ten (10) calendar days before the deadline set for the submission and receipt of Bids.

10. Documents Comprising the Bid: Eligibility and Technical Components

- 10.1. The first envelope shall contain the eligibility and technical documents of the Bid as specified in Section IX. Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents.
- 10.2. If the eligibility requirements or statements, the bids, and all other documents for submission to the BAC are in foreign language other than English, it must be accompanied by a translation in English, which shall be authenticated by the appropriate Philippine foreign service establishment, post, or the equivalent office having jurisdiction over the foreign bidder's affairs in the Philippines. For Contracting Parties to the Apostille Convention, only the translated documents shall be authenticated through an apostille pursuant to GPPB Resolution No. 13-2019 dated 23 May 2019. The English translation shall govern, for purposes of interpretation of the bid.
- 10.3. A valid PCAB License is required, and in case of joint ventures, a valid special PCAB License, and registration for the type and cost of the contract for this Project. Any additional type of Contractor license or permit shall be indicated in the BDS.
- 10.4. A List of Contractor's key personnel (e.g., Project Manager, Project Engineers, Materials Engineers, and Foremen) assigned to the contract to be bid, with their complete qualification and experience data shall be provided. These key personnel must meet the required minimum years of experience set in the BDS.
- 10.5. A List of Contractor's major equipment units, which are owned, leased, and/or under purchase agreements, supported by proof of ownership, certification of availability of equipment from the equipment lessor/vendor for the duration of the project, as the case may be, must meet the minimum requirements for the contract set in the BDS.

11. Documents Comprising the Bid: Financial Component

- 11.1. The second bid envelope shall contain the financial documents for the Bid as specified in Section IX. Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents.
- 11.2. Any bid exceeding the ABC indicated in paragraph 1 of the IB shall not be accepted.
- For Foreign-funded procurement, a ceiling may be applied to bid prices provided the conditions are met under Section 31.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

12. Alternative Bids

Bidders shall submit offers that comply with the requirements of the Bidding Documents, including the basic technical design as indicated in the drawings and specifications. Unless there is a value engineering clause in the BDS, alternative Bids shall not be accepted.

13.Bid Prices

All bid prices for the given scope of work in the Project as awarded shall be considered as fixed prices, and therefore not subject to price escalation during contract implementation, except under extraordinary circumstances as determined by the NEDA and approved by the GPPB pursuant to the revised Guidelines for Contract Price Escalation guidelines.

14.Bid and Payment Currencies

- Bid prices may be quoted in the local currency or tradeable currency accepted by the BSP at the discretion of the Bidder. However, for purposes of bid evaluation, Bids denominated in foreign currencies shall be converted to Philippine currency based on the exchange rate as published in the BSP reference rate bulletin on the day of the bid opening.
- 14.2. Payment of the contract price shall be made in:
 - a. Philippine Pesos.

15.Bid Security

- The Bidder shall submit a Bid Securing Declaration or any form of Bid Security in the amount indicated in the BDS, which shall be not less than the percentage of the ABC in accordance with the schedule in the BDS.
- The Bid and bid security shall be valid until One Hundred Twenty (120) 15.2. Calendar Days from the Scheduled Bid Opening. Any bid not accompanied

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by an acceptable bid security shall be rejected by the Procuring Entity as non-responsive.

16.Sealing and Marking of Bids

Each Bidder shall submit one copy of the first and second components of its Bid.

The Procuring Entity may request additional hard copies and/or electronic copies of the Bid. However, failure of the Bidders to comply with the said request shall not be a ground for disqualification.

If the Procuring Entity allows the submission of bids through online submission to the given website or any other electronic means, the Bidder shall submit an electronic copy of its Bid, which must be digitally signed. An electronic copy that cannot be opened or is corrupted shall be considered non-responsive and, thus, automatically disqualified.

17. Deadline for Submission of Bids

The Bidders shall submit on the specified date and time and either at its physical address or through online submission as indicated in paragraph 7 of the IB.

18. Opening and Preliminary Examination of Bids

18.1. The BAC shall open the Bids in public at the time, on the date, and at the place specified in paragraph 9 of the IB. The Bidders' representatives who are present shall sign a register evidencing their attendance. In case videoconferencing, webcasting or other similar technologies will be used, attendance of participants shall likewise be recorded by the BAC Secretariat.

In case the Bids cannot be opened as scheduled due to justifiable reasons, the rescheduling requirements under Section 29 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 shall prevail.

18.2. The preliminary examination of Bids shall be governed by Section 30 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

19. Detailed Evaluation and Comparison of Bids

- 19.1. The Procuring Entity's BAC shall immediately conduct a detailed evaluation of all Bids rated "passed" using non-discretionary pass/fail criteria. The BAC shall consider the conditions in the evaluation of Bids under Section 32.2 of 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 19.2. If the Project allows partial bids, all Bids and combinations of Bids as indicated in the BDS shall be received by the same deadline and opened and evaluated simultaneously so as to determine the Bid or combination of Bids offering the lowest calculated cost to the Procuring Entity. Bid Security as

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required by ITB Clause 16 shall be submitted for each contract (lot) separately.

19.3. In all cases, the NFCC computation pursuant to Section 23.4.2.6 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 must be sufficient for the total of the ABCs for all the lots participated in by the prospective Bidder.

20.Post Qualification

Within a non-extendible period of five (5) calendar days from receipt by the Bidder of the notice from the BAC that it submitted the Lowest Calculated Bid, the Bidder shall submit its latest income and business tax returns filed and paid through the BIR Electronic Filing and Payment System (eFPS), and other appropriate licenses and permits required by law and stated in the BDS.

21. Signing of the Contract

The documents required in Section 37.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 shall form part of the Contract. Additional Contract documents are indicated in the BDS.

SECTION III- GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. Scope of Contract

This Contract shall include all such items, although not specifically mentioned, that can be reasonably inferred as being required for its completion as if such items were expressly mentioned herein. All the provisions of RA No. 9184 and its 2016 revised IRR, including the Generic Procurement Manual, and associated issuance s, constitute the primary source for the terms and conditions of the Contract, and thus, applicable in contract implementation. Herein clauses shall serve as the secondary source for the terms and conditions of the Contract.

This is without prejudice to Sections 74.1 and 74.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 allowing the GPPB to amend the IRR, which shall be applied to all procurement activities, the advertisement, posting, or invitation of which were issued after the effectivity of the said amendment.

2. Sectional Completion of Works

If sectional completion is specified in the Special Conditions of Contract (SCC), references in the Conditions of Contract to the Works, the Completion Date, and the Intended Completion Date shall apply to any Section of the Works (other than references to the Completion Date and Intended Completion Date for the whole of the Works).

3. Possession of Site

- The Procuring Entity shall give possession of all or parts of the Site to the 4.1. Contractor based on the schedule of delivery indicated in the SCC, which corresponds to the execution of the Works. If the Contractor suffers delay or incurs cost from failure on the part of the Procuring Entity to give possession in accordance with the terms of this clause, the Procuring Entity's Representative shall give the Contractor a Contract Time Extension and certify such sum as fair to cover the cost incurred, which sum shall be paid by Procuring Entity.
- If possession of a portion is not given by the above date, the Procuring Entity 4.2. will be deemed to have delayed the start of the relevant activities. The resulting adjustments in contract time to address such delay may be addressed through contract extension provided under Annex "E" of the 2016 revised IRR. of RA No. 9184.

4. The Contractor's Obligations

The Contractor shall employ the key personnel named in the Schedule of Key Personnel indicating their designation, in accordance with ITB Clause 10.3 and specified in the BDS, to carry out the supervision of the Works.

SECTION III- GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

The Procuring Entity will approve any proposed replacement of key personnel only if their relevant qualifications and abilities are equal to or better than those of the personnel listed in the Schedule.

5. Performance Security

- 5.1. Within ten (10) calendar days from receipt of the Notice of Award from the Procuring Entity but in no case later than the signing of the contract by both parties, the successful Bidder shall furnish the performance security in any of the forms prescribed in Section 39 of the 2016 revised IRR.
- 5.2. The Contractor, by entering into the Contract with the Procuring Entity, acknowledges the right of the Procuring Entity to institute action pursuant to RA No. 3688 against any subcontractor be they an individual, firm, partnership, corporation, or association supplying the Contractor with labor, materials and/or equipment for the performance of this Contract.

6. Site Investigation Reports

The Contractor, in preparing the Bid, shall rely on any Site Investigation Reports referred to in the SCC supplemented by any information obtained by the Contractor.

7. Warranty

- 7.1. In case the Contractor fails to undertake the repair works under Section 62.2.2 of the 2016 revised IRR, the Procuring Entity shall forfeit its performance security, subject its property(ics) to attachment or garnishment proceedings, and perpetually disqualify it from participating in any public bidding. All payables of the GOP in his favor shall be offset to recover the costs.
- 7.2. The warranty against Structural Defects/Failures, except that occasioned-on force majeure, shall cover the period from the date of issuance of the Certificate of Final Acceptance by the Procuring Entity. Specific duration of the warranty is found in the SCC.

8. Liability of the Contractor

Subject to additional provisions, if any, set forth in the SCC, the Contractor's liability under this Contract shall be as provided by the laws of the Republic of the Philippines.

If the Contractor is a joint venture, all partners to the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable to the Procuring Entity.

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9. Termination for Other Causes

Contract termination shall be initiated in case it is determined prima facie by the Procuring Entity that the Contractor has engaged, before, or during the implementation of the contract, in unlawful deeds and behaviors relative to contract acquisition and implementation, such as, but not limited to corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, coercive, and obstructive practices as stated in ITB Clause 4.

10.Dayworks

Subject to the guidelines on Variation Order in Annex "E" of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, and if applicable as indicated in the SCC, the Dayworks rates in the Contractor's Bid shall be used for small additional amounts of work only when the Procuring Entity's Representative has given written instructions in advance for additional work to be paid for in that way.

11.Program of Work

- 11.1. The Contractor shall submit to the Procuring Entity's Representative for approval the said Program of Work showing the general methods, arrangements, order, and timing for all the activities in the Works. The submissions of the Program of Work are indicated in the SCC.
- The Contractor shall submit to the Procuring Entity's Representative for approval an updated Program of Work at intervals no longer than the period stated in the SCC. If the Contractor does not submit an updated Program of Work within this period, the Procuring Entity's Representative may withhold the amount stated in the SCC from the next payment certificate and continue to withhold this amount until the next payment after the date on which the overdue Program of Work has been submitted.

12.Instructions, Inspections and Audits

The Contractor shall permit the GOP or the Procuring Entity to inspect the Contractor's accounts and records relating to the performance of the Contractor and to have them andited by auditors of the GOP or the Procuring Entity, as may be required.

13. Advance Payment

The Procuring Entity shall, upon a written request of the Contractor which shall be submitted as a Contract document, make an advance payment to the Contractor in an amount not exceeding lifteen percent (15%) of the total contract price, to be made in lump sum, or at the most two installments according to a schedule specified in the SCC, subject to the requirements in Annex "E" of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

SECTION III- GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

14. Progress Payments

The Contractor may submit a request for payment for Work accomplished. Such requests for payment shall be verified and certified by the Procuring Entity's Representative/Project Engineer. Except as otherwise stipulated in the SCC, materials and equipment delivered on the site but not completely put in place shall not be included for payment.

15. Operating and Maintenance Manuals

- 15.1. If required, the Contractor will provide "as built" Drawings and/or operating and maintenance manuals as specified in the SCC.
- 15.2. If the Contractor does not provide the Drawings and/or manuals by the dates stated above, or they do not receive the Procuring Entity's Representative's approval, the Procuring Entity's Representative may withhold the amount stated in the SCC from payments due to the Contractor.

CW - CIVIL WORKS

CW-1.0 GENERAL SCOPE

This section covers the Construction of Multi-Purpose Gymnasium Building and other appurtenant structures, moving-in of the Contractor's construction equipment, setting up of the Contractor's various facilities at the end of the Contract.

CW 1.2 MATERIALS

CW 1.3 WORKMANSHIP

The Contractor shall bring to the site all his necessary construction equipment and plant and install all stationary construction equipment and plant at location and in the manner approved by NPC. The Contractor shall submit sufficient detailed plans showing the proposed location of such stationary equipment and plant and other pertinent data.

The Contractor shall provide and grade his camp site, construct his camp, employee housing, warehouse and provide such related facilities and sanitary conveniences that the Contractor deems necessary for maintaining health, peace and order in the camp and work areas. The areas that may be used by the Contractor within the construction site shall be designated by NPC.

CW 1.4 MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

Work prescribed herein shall not be measured and paid separately; same shall be deemed to be included in pay items for other items for work.

CW 2.0 CONSTRUCTION SAFETY AND HEALTH

CW 2.1 GENERAL SCOPE

This section pertains to the safety and health provisions, requirements and conditions that shall govern during the execution under this project.

CW 2.2 GENERAL CONDITIONS

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The contractor shall ensure compliance with the applicable safety and health regulations during the construction of this project through the implementation that include, but not limited to, the following:

- Designate a Safety officer who shall respectively handle all safety and health concerns of the project;
- Properly manage debris and various waste generated during construction in a designated or NPC approved disposal area;



CW 3.0 EARTHWORKS

CW 3.1 EXCAVATION

CW 3.1.1 GENERAL SCOPE



This item shall consist of excavation and the disposal of material in accordance with the Specification and in conformity with the lines, grades and dimensions shown on the Plans or established by the NPC Engineer.

CW 3.1.2 MATERIALS

CW 3.1.3 WORKMANSHIP

All excavations shall be finished to reasonably smooth and uniform surfaces. No materials shall be wasted without authority of the NPC Engineer. Excavation operations shall be conducted so that material outside of the limits of slopes will not be disturbed.

All suitable materials removed from the excavation shall be used in the formation of the embankment, sub-grade, shoulders, slopes, bedding, and backfill for structures, and for other purposes shown on the Plans or as directed.

Only approved materials shall be used in the construction of embankments and backfills.

All excess materials, including rock and boulders that cannot be used in embankments shall be disposed off as directed.

CW 3.1.4 MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

Unit of measure shall be the net volume in its original position.

The accepted quantities shall be paid for at the contract unit price included in the Bill of Quantities which price and payment shall be full compensation for the removal and disposal of excavated materials including all labor, equipment, tools, and incidentals necessary to complete the work prescribed in this Item.

CW 4.2 BACKFILLING

CW 4.2.1 GENERAL SCOPE

This item shall consist of furnishing, placing and compacting soil on top of existing soft seabed material encountered and found unsuitable for foundation of the concrete which shall be constructed in accordance with the Plans.





CW 4.2.2 MATERIALS

All rocks to be used shall be hard durable, and not likely to disintegrate in sea/lake water. Rocks shall weigh not less than 1,900 kilograms per cubic meter (specific gravity — 1.9) or approximately 19.05 kilo Newton (kN) per cubic meter of solid materials. Rocks shall be angular. Sub-angular rocks may be used subject to the approval of the NPC Engineer. Rounded or well rounded rocks will not be accepted.

Concrete filler for the purpose of preventing escape of fill material, shall be class "B" concrete plus 10% additional cement.

CW 4 2 3 WORKMANSHIP

The larger pieces of facing rock shall be laid carefully along the toe with allowance being made for possible settlement. These rows of large rocks shall be extended to maintain slightly in advance of the completed portion of work. The larger pieces of rock shall be palce on the outer slope of the concrete and they shall be laid so their longest dimension will be approximately normal to the plane of the face of the slope as indicated in the plans.

The work shall be done in skillfull manner, which implies careful selection of rocks to fit properly together so that the finished surface shall be even and tight.

CW 4.2.4 MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

Backfilling will be measured by cubic meter (cu.m.). The quantity to be paid for shall be the design volume compacted in-place as shown on the Plans and accepted in the completed course.

The accepted quantities shall be paid for at the contract unit price for Backfilling which price and payment shall be full compensation for furnishings and placing all materials, including all labor, equipment, tools and incidentals necessary to complete the work prescribed in this Item.

CW 4.0 GRAVEL BEDDING

CW 5.1. GENERAL SCOPE



In accordance with the plans and these specifications, the Contractor shall furnish all materials' labor, equipment, tools and perform in accordance with the drawings or as otherwise directed.

CW 5.2 MATERIALS

CW 5.2.1 BEDDING

Bed course for the approach slab shall be aggregate sub-base same as used in Road concrete pavements.

CW 5.2.2 CONCRETE

Concrete shall be 17.24 MPa or as indicated in the drawings.

CW 5.2.3 REINFORCING STEEL

Reinforcing Steel Bars shall conform to the requirements of PNS 49:2002 for grade DSB-275.

CW 5.3 WORKMANSHIP

Prior to the placing of Bedding course, the foundation shall be prepared by compacting and bringing it to unyielding or firm surface. Compaction shall be attended by either wetting or drying, as the case may be, to attain satisfactory compaction of the foundation.

Mixing, placing, finishing and curing concrete shall conform to the requirements of ACI code for Concrete Construction.

CW 5.4 MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

It will be based on the number of cubic meters for the Bedding and Concrete while the Reinforcement Bars will be based on pieces.



The accepted quantities shall be paid for at the contract unit price included in the Bill of Quantities which price and payment shall be full compensation for the removal and disposal of excavated materials including all labor, equipment, tools, and incidentals necessary to complete the work prescribed in this Item.

CW 6.0 STRUCTURAL CONCRETE WORKS

CW 6.1 GENERAL SCOPE

This item shall consist of furnishing, placing and finishing concrete in accordance with the specification and conforming to the lines, grades, and dimension shown on the plans.

CW 6.2 MATERIALS

CW 6.2.1 Portland Cement and Masonry Cement

Cement shall conform to the requirements of the following cited Specifications for the type specified or permitted.

Only Type I Portland Cement shall be used unless otherwise provided for in the Special Provisions. Different brands or the same brands from different mills shall not be mixed nor shall they be used alternately unless the mix is approved by the Engineer.

The Contractor shall provide suitable means of storing and protecting the cement against dampness. Cement which, for any reason, has become partially set or which contains lumps of caked cement will be rejected. Cement salvaged from discarded or used bags shall not be used.

The compressive strength of mortar samples tested at 7 days can be considered for acceptance of cement quality provided that the strength of the samples at 7 days is not less than 23.46 MPa which is 85% of the compressive strength requirement for 28 days (27.6 MPa) when tested in accordance with ASTM C 150.

CW 6.2.1 CONCRETE AGGREGATES



CW 6.2.1.1 Fine Aggregate

It shall consist of natural sand, stone screenings or other inert materials with similar characteristics, or combinations thereof, having hard, strong and durable particles. Fine aggregate from different sources of supply shall not be mixed or stored in the same pile nor used alternately in the same class of concrete without the approval of the Engineer.

It shall not contain more than three (3) mass percent of material passing the 0.075 mm (No. 200 sieve) by washing nor more than one (1) mass percent each of clay lumps or shale. If the fine aggregate is subjected to five (5) cycles of the sodium sulfate soundness test, the weighted loss shall not exceed 10 mass percent. It shall be free from injurious amounts of organic impurities.

The fine aggregate shall be well-graded from coarse to fine and shall conform to the Grading Requirements listed below:

CW 6.2.1.2 Coarse Aggregate

It shall consist of crushed stone, gravel, blast furnace slag, or other approved inert materials of similar characteristics, or combinations thereof, having hard, strong, durable pieces and free from any adherent coatings.


It shall contain not more than one (1) mass percent of material passing the 0.075 mm (No. 200) sieve, not more than 0.25 mass percent of clay lumps, nor more than 3.5 mass percent of soft fragments.

If the coarse aggregate is subjected to five (5) cycles of the sodium sulfate soundness test, the weighted loss shall not exceed 12 mass percent. It shall have a mass percent of wear not exceeding 40 when tested by AASHTO T 96.

Only one grading specification shall be used from any one source.

CW 6.2.1.2 Water

Water used in mixing, curing or other designated application shall be reasonably clean and free of oil, salt, acid, alkali, grass or other substances injurious to the finished product. Water will be tested in accordance with and shall meet the requirements of Item 714, Water. Water which is drinkable may be used without test. Where the source of water is shallow, the intake shall be so enclosed as to exclude silt, mud, grass or other foreign materials.

CW 6.3WORKMANSHIP

The proportions of aggregate to cement for any concrete shall be such as to produce a mixture which will work readily into the corners and angles of the form and around reinforcement with the method of placing employed on the work, but without permitting the materials to segregate or excess free water to collect on the surface. The methods of measuring concrete materials shall be such that the proportions can be accurately controlled and easily checked at any time during the work.

The proportion of fine aggregate, coarse aggregate and cement to attain the required strength shall be 1:2:4, One (1) part Cement in bag; Two (2) parts Sand in Cubic meter; and Four (4) parts Gravel in Cubic meter.

Water-cement ratios for strengths greater than that shown in Table below may be used provided that the relationship between strength and watercement ratio for the materials to be used has been previously established by reliable test data and the resulting concrete satisfies the requirements of concrete quality.

Bar reinforcement for concrete structures, except No. 2 bars shall be deformed in accordance with AASHTO M 42, M 31 and M 53 for Nos. 3 to 11

Dowel and tie bars shall conform to the requirements of AASHTO M 31 (ASTM A 615/PNS 49) or AASHTO M 42 except that rail steel shall not be used for tie bars that are to be bent and re-straightened during construction. Tie bars shall be deformed bars. Dowel bars shall be plain round bars. They shall be free from burring or other deformation restricting slippage in the concrete. Before delivery to the site of the work, a minimum of one half (1/2) the length of each dowel bar shall be painted with one coat of approved lead or tar paint.

The sleeves for dowel bars shall be metal of an approved design to cover 50 mm, plus or minus 6.3 mm of the dowel, with a closed end, and with a suitable stop to hold the end of the sleeve at least 25 mm from the end of the dowel bar. Sleeves shall be of such design that they do not collapse during construction.

Plastic coated dowel bar conforming to AASHTO M 254 may be used.

CW 7.3 WORKMANSHIP

All steel reinforcement shall be accurately placed in the position shown on the Plans or as required by the NPC Engineer and firmly held there during the placing and setting of the concrete. Bars shall be tied at all intersections except where 238 spacing is less than 300 mm in each directions, in which case, alternate intersections shall be tied. Ties shall be fastened on the inside.

Steel reinforcement shall be stored above the surface of the ground upon platforms, skids, or other supports and shall be protected as far as practicable from mechanical injury and surface deterioration caused by exposure to conditions producing rust. When placed in the work, reinforcement shall be free from dirt, detrimental rust, loose scale, paint,





grease, oil, or other foreign materials. Reinforcement shall be free from injurious defects such as cracks and laminations.

All reinforcement shall be furnished in the full lengths indicated on the Plans. Splicing of bars, except where shown on the Plans, will not be permitted without the written approval of the Engineer. Splices shall be staggered as far as possible and with a minimum separation of not less than 40 bar diameters. Not more than one-third of the bars may be spliced in the same cross-section, except where shown on the Plans.

CW 7.4 MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

The quantity of concrete to be paid shall be the quantity shown in the Bid Schedule in kilogram.

The accepted quantity, measured as prescribed in the Bid Schedule, shall be paid for at the contract unit price for Reinforcing Steel which price and payment shall be full compensation for furnishing and placing all materials, including all labor, equipment, tools and incidentals necessary to complete the work prescribed in this Item.

CW 8.0 ROOFING AND TRUSSES WORKS

CW 8.1 GENERAL SCOPE

This Item shall consist of furnishing, fabricating and placing all steel trusses in accordance with the AISC "Manual of Steel Construction" and pre-painted metal sheet materials, tools and equipment, plant including labor required in undertaking the proper installation complete as shown on the Plans and in accordance with this Specification.

CW 8.2 MATERIALS

Materials for steel trusses shall be of the best quality of their kind, well graded and within the all allowable distortions, however, they shall be free from flakes, corrosion, scale of fragments that could reduce the resistance and durability or injure the external appearance.

Pre-painted roofing sheets shall be fabricated from cold rolled galvanized iron sheets specially tempered steel for extra strength and durability. It shall conform to the material requirements defined in PNS 67: 1985. Profile section in identifying the architectural moulded rib to be used are as follows: Regular corrugated, Quad-rib, Tri-wave, Rib-wide, twin-rib, etc. Desired color shall be subject to the approval of the Architect/Engineer.





Gutters, Valleys, Flashings Hip and Ridge roll shall be fabricated from gauge 24 (.600 mm thick) cold-rolled plain galvanized iron sheets specially tempered steel. Profile section shall be as indicated on the Plans.

Fastening hardware shall be of galvanized iron straps and rivets. G.I. straps are of .500 mm thick \times 16 mm wide \times 267 mm long (gauge 26 \times 5/8" \times 10-1/2") and standard rivets.

CW 8.3 WORKMANSHIP

Materials shall conform to the respective specifications specified herein. Materials not otherwise specified herein shall conform to the AISC "manual of Steel Construction".


All welding works shall be as indicated on the drawings and shall conform to AWS DLI 77 "Structural Welding Code". Unless specified on the drawings, fillet welds shall be a minimum of 5mm (3/16") and welding electrodes shall be with a tensile strength of 485 MPa.

All welding works shall be executed by the AWS D1.1 qualified welders, welding operators and trackers, whose workmanship shall be subject to the approval of NPC.

Roofing installation shall start by placing the first sheet in position with the downturned edge in line with other building elements and fastened to supports as recommended.

Place the downturned edge of the next sheet over the edge of the first sheet, to provide side lap and hold the side lap firmly in place. Continue the same procedure for subsequent sheets until the whole roofing area is covered and/or (Adopt installation procedure provided in the instruction manual for each type of Architectural molded rib profile section).

Pre-painted steel roofing, walling products and accessories should be delivered to the jobsite in strapped bundles. Sheets and/or bundles shall be



neatly stacked in the ground and if left in the open it shall be protected by covering the stack materials with loose tarpaulin.

Where so indicated on the Plans, structural members shall be joined by welding. The welds shall be of the size and type indicated and shall be made by competent operators.

CW 8.4 MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

The unit of measure shall be in lot.

The accepted quantity, measured as prescribed in the Bid Schedule, shall be paid for at the contract unit price which price and payment shall be full compensation for furnishing and placing all materials, including all labor, equipment, tools and incidentals necessary to complete the work prescribed in this Item.

CW 9.1 BASKETBALL HOOP, BACKBOARD, COURT & ACCESSORIES.

CW 9.1 GENERAL SCOPE

The work to be done under this item shall include the furnishing of all labor, materials, equipment, tools and other incidentals to complete the work.

CW 9.2 MATERIALS

All the materials under this scope including its size shall be shown in the drawings or as specified in the Bill of Quantities.

All the materials and its fixtures and fittings must bear the trademarks of the manufacturer. All installation without the trademarks shall be removed and replaced with properly marked fittings without extra cost to the NPC.

CW 9.3 WORKMANSHIP

All materials including its fixtures shall be installed free and open in a manner to afford access for cleaning. All brackets, cleat, plates and anchors required to support the fixtures shall be furnished in a rigidly manner.

CW 9.4 MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

Unit of measure shall be in lot.

The accepted quantities shall be paid for at the contract unit price included in the Bill of Quantities which price and payment shall be full compensation for the removal and disposal of excavated materials including all labor, equipment, tools, and incidentals necessary to complete the work prescribed in this Item.

CW 10.0 PROJECT LANDMARK AND SIGNAGE

CW 10.1 GENERAL SCOPE

This item shall consist of furnishing, fabricating and placing of the project Landmark and signage of the type, size, shape and grade required, as well as painting of the same in accordance with the Specification and in conformity with the requirements shown on the Plans or as directed by the NPC Engineer.

CW 10.2 MATERIALS

The materials to be used for the Landmark and signage shall conform with the requirements shown on the Plans or as directed by the NPC Engineer.

All paint materials shall meet the requirements of the Philippine National Standard Specifications for Paintings.

Paints shall be brought to the Site in tightly closeable, convenient, original containers, if nothing to the contrary is stipulated in the Specifications. The containers shall be marked in a durable manner with the following particulars:

- Maker
- Paint and relevant thinner
- Gross and net weights
- Date of supply by the maker's factory



With the exception of ready-mixed materials in original containers, all mixing shall be done at the job site. No materials are to be reduced or changed except as specified by the Manufacturer of said materials.

Surfaces to be painted must be thoroughly inspected. There might be some portion that needs further re-surfing and finishing. For wood surface, apply Davies Interior Primer & Sealer followed by Gloss-It Quick Drying Enamel with at least Two (2) coats.

CW 10.3 WORKMANSHIP

The Contractor prior to commencement of the painting, varnishing and related work shall examine the surfaces to be applied in order not to jeopardize the quality and appearances of the painting varnishing and related works.

All surfaces shall be in proper condition to receive the finish. Woodworks shall be hand-sanded smooth and dusted clean. All knotholes pitch pockets or sappy portions shall be sealed with natural wood filler. Nail holes, cracks or defects shall be carefully puttied after the first coat, matching the color of paint.

Interior woodworks shall be sandpapered between coats. Cracks, holes of imperfections in plaster shall be filled with patching compound and smoothed off to match adjoining surfaces.

Concrete and masonry surfaces shall be coated with concrete neutralizer and allowed to dry before any painting primer coat is applied. When surface is dried apply first coating. Hairline cracks and unevenness shall be patched and sealed with approved putty or patching compound.

After all defects are corrected apply the finish coats as specified on the Plans (color scheme approved).

Metal shall be clean, dry and free from mill scale and rust. Remove all grease and oil from surfaces. Wash unprimed galvanized metal with etching solution and allow it to dry.

Paints when applied by brush shall become non-fluid, thick enough to lay down as adequate film of wet paint. Brush marks shall flaw out after application of paint.

Paints made for application by roller must be similar to brushing paint. It must be nonstick when thinned to spraying viscosity so that it will break up easily into droplets.





CW 10.4 MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

The unit of measure shall be in lot.

CW-11.3 WORKMANSHIP

All work shall be done by skilled painters in a workmanlike manner. All paints shall be evenly applied Two (2) coats so as to be free from sags, runs, crawls or other defects. All painting materials shall be meet the requirements of stress and shall be in accordance with the relevant standards. All coatings shall be of proper consistency and well brushed out so as to show the minimum of brush marks, except varnish and enamel which shall be uniformly flowed on. All brushes shall be clean and in good condition, with heavy brushes preferred. Light brushes shall not be permitted.

Paint shall be thoroughly stirred so as to keep the pigment evenly in suspension when paint is being applied.

No painting shall be done under conditions that are unsuitable for the production of good results. No oil painting shall be done in damp weather.

Application of succeeding coats shall strictly follow the over-coating times specified by the paint manufacturer. If no specific data are available, all coats shall be thoroughly dry before painting shall be applied. At least twenty-four (24) hours shall be allowed between coats. Exterior painting under damp/wet conditions is not allowed.

Painting coat as specified are intended to cover the surfaces perfectly, if surfaces are not fully covered, further coat shall be applied to attain the desired evenness of the paint application.

All parts of mouldings and ornaments shall be left clean and true to details. All finish shall be uniform as to sheen, color and texture, except when glazing is required.

CW 11.4 MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

The unit of measure shall be in square meter.

The accepted quantity, measured as prescribed in the Bid Schedule, shall be paid for at the contract unit price which price and payment shall be full compensation for furnishing and placing all materials, including all labor, equipment, tools and incidentals necessary to complete the work prescribed in this Item.
