3. Delivery Point

4. Bid Submission

The Bidder shall submit their bids through their authorized representative or in the manner of submission as prescribed in the RFQ.

5. Late Bids

Any Bid submitted after the deadline for submission and receipt of Bids shall not be accepted by NPC.

6. Bid Prices

The bid price as indicated in the Quotation Form shall be fixed during the Bidder's performance of the Contract and not subject to variation or price escalation on any account. A Bid submitted with an adjustable price quotation shall be treated as non-responsive.

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7. Bid Price Validity

Price Validity shall not be less than One Hundred Twenty (120) calendar days from date of bid submission.

8. Eligibility Criteria

- a. Bids shall be checked using the PASS / FAIL Criteria for Legal, Technical and Financial components.
- b. From the bids that were rated PASSED, the same shall be ranked and corrected for computational errors to identify the Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB).

9. Detailed Evaluation and Comparison of Bids

The LCB shall be subjected to detailed evaluation against the Technical Specifications including arithmetical computations. Documents which are deemed not to comply with the requirements of the tender shall be considered non-complying.

10. Post-qualification

Submitted documents of the LCB shall be subjected to post qualification evaluation.

 Latest Income Tax Return / Business Tax Return shall be submitted during postqualification.

The bid that PASSED the Post-Qualification shall be declared as the Single /Lowest Calculated Responsive Bid (S/LCRB).

11. Total Contract Price

The Total Contract Price shall be inclusive of all taxes and other related expenses / charges.

12. Notice to Supplier

- a. The supplier shall pick-up the Purchase Order (PO)/ Notice to Proceed (NTP) from NPC within two (2) calendar days from receipt of the Notice of Award.
- b. Failure to secure the PO/NTP by the supplier within the said period will mean cancellation of the same and imposition of penalties as prescribed by law.

13. PO Effectivity

a. The PO Shall take effect immediately upon receipt of the PO / NTP by the supplier sent through fax as evidenced by the fax transmission receipt and as confirmed by the supplier's representative.

14. Terms of Payment

Terms of Payment shall be thirty (30) calendar days after submission of complete supporting documents.

15. Warranty

Unless otherwise provided in the RFQ, the warranty period shall be a minimum of one (1) year from the date of final acceptance by the end-user.

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16. Liquidated Damages

Where the supplier refuses or fails to satisfactorily complete the work within the specified contract time, plus any time of extension duly granted and is hereby in default under the contract, the supplier shall pay NPC for liquidated damages, and not by way of penalty, an amount equal to at least one tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the cost of the undelivered/unperformed portion of the items/works for every day of delay until actual delivery or performance. Once the amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%), the procuring entity may rescind or terminate the contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it (GCC Clause 23 of the Revised IRR of RA 9184).

17. Liability of the Supplier

If after receipt of the Purchase Order, the supplier fails to deliver the goods, appropriate sanctions will be imposed as prescribed under Republic Act (RA) 9184 and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR).

18. Disclosure of Relations

The bidder shall comply with the provisions of Section 47 of RA 9184 and its revised IRR re: disclosure of relations.

19. Administrative Sanctions

Bidder shall likewise be imposed the rules as stated in section 69 (Imposition of administrative penalties) should there be infractions committed.

20. Reservation Clause

NPC reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process, and to reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder/s.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS / SCOPE OF WORKS

SUPPLY, INSTALLATION, TESTING AND COMMISSIONING OF FIRE SUPPRESSION CONTROL PANEL UL/FM 2 UNITS AT CENTRAL RECORDS STORAGE ,NPC HEAD OFFICE, QUEZON CITY

SCOPE OF WORKS

Below are the scope of works to be done which shall start upon receipt of the Notice to Proceed:

- 1. Install Fire Suppression Control Panel compatible to the existing system including AVR for each Panel
- 2. Re-piping if necessary.
- 3. Paint all electrical piping together with the electrical box.
- 4. Power up the system to perform initial function test in coordination with the TFMD Personnel.
- 5. Power down the system after testing and apply for the final testing and commissioning in coordination with the TFMD Personnel.
- 6. Check the Light Emitting Diode (LCD) displays and all wiring terminal per circuit of the alarm control panel.
- 7. Check program and proper display of all field devices of the Fire Suppression Control Panel.
- 8. Test the fire suppression control panel using AC and DC operation.
- 9. Random test of Smoke, Heat Detectors, Manual Pull Station, and Alarm Bell (audible & signal).
- 10. Test the back-up battery for about ten (10) minutes without AC power supply.

DELIVERY PERIOD

The delivery period shall be sixty (60) calendar days upon receipt of the purchase order/contract or notice to proceed.

LIABILITY/INDEMNITY FOR LOSS AND/OR DAMAGES

Contractor shall be liable and shall indemnify NPC for any loss, damages or injury of NPC due to or arising from the fault, negligence, vandalism or other unlawful acts of its employees/workers.

Contractor shall also be held liable to, and indemnity third (3rd) person/s for claim/s arising from the fault and/or negligence of its employees/workers assigned in the premises of the NPC.

NPC shall have the right to deduct from any money payable to the Contractor amount/s equivalent to any damage it may suffer or liability it may incur due to the fault or negligence of the latter's workers.

WARRANTY

After completion of works:

For one (1) year against factory defects/workmanships.

MODE OF PAYMENT

Payment shall be within thirty (30) days upon suppliers completion of project, submission of invoice, service/acknowledgement reports and issuance of certificate of acceptance on completion from the manager/end-user, TFMD-GSD, and submission of other supporting documents by NPC.
