Ms. Sharon S. Garin was appointed Officer-in-Charge of the Department of Energy (DOE) on 23 May 2025. Prior to this appointment, she served as Undersecretary of the DOE, where she oversaw financial and legal services and chaired the Nuclear Energy Program Interagency Committee. In this capacity, she led key initiatives including the regulation of retail energy outlets, the facilitation of offshore wind permitting, and the streamlining of renewable energy service contracts.

OIC Garin brings with her a wealth of legislative experience, having served in Congress for over a decade. During her tenure, she championed agricultural and economic reforms, authoring and supporting landmark bills on mango industry modernization, pesticide regulation, and biotechnology reform, among others.

She holds a bachelor's degree in Accounting from the University of the Philippines Visayas–Iloilo City, a law degree from the Ateneo de Manila University, and a Master of Business Administration from ESADE Business School in Barcelona. •
