For more than three decades with NPC, Mr. Umali has grown and proved himself in various roles and ascending ranks in watershed management. He was finally made Department Manager of Watershed Management in 2003, overseeing the management of the eleven (11) watershed reservations in the country that support power generation, irrigation, and domestic water supply.

As WMD's manager, he was responsible for shaping policies that would better the rehabilitation and protection efforts of NPC in the watersheds, initiating partnerships to expedite its programs, and implementing a systematic approach to grant personalized programs in the communities in the watershed. He has likewise mentored several foresters who would soon take the helm of NPC's efforts to preserve and protect the forests.

Throughout his illustrious career, Mr. Umali has amassed a wealth of accolades and achievements, earning recognition for his instrumental role in managing over 500,000 hectares of reservation including the 2019 roster of Outstanding Professionals, awarded by the Professional Regulatory Commission (PRC).

His tireless advocacy for best practices and his ability to navigate complex challenges with grace and determination have solidified his reputation as a respected leader in his field and have earned him an opportunity to hold a bigger role within NPC, albeit temporarily – the leading of the Corporate Affairs Group as OIC Vice President. ■
