NPC's APPROACH TO WASTE MANAGEMENT

- Segregation at source
- Waste Characterization and Analysis
- Waste Reduction, Resource Conservation, Reuse/Recycling
- Proper collection
- Proper storage
- Proper disposal
- Monitoring and review/evaluation

RESPONSIBILITIES

- VP-AF administer the compliance with the Waste Management Guidelines.
- TFMD/GSD lead the implementation of the guidelines
- Waste Management Team (5S Monitoring Team)
 - monitor the implementation
 - review the effectiveness of the waste management system.
- HO-Pollution Control Officer (PCO)
 - responsible for the management of hazardous wastes and compliance with relevant DENR requirements.

RESPONSIBILITIES


- WIADD responsible for the disposal of used oils,
 WEEE, scraps and other wastes that are covered by the procedure on the disposal of NPC assets
- CRTDD responsible for the storage and disposal of all paper wastes (bond paper)

EMD

- provide assistance to the TFMD in implementing the guidelines and formulating and reviewing the waste management policies
- conduct periodic audit of the waste management system

Styropor, plastic cups/ fork/spoon, aluminum foil, milk cartons, tetrapacks, sachet packs, soiled plastic bags, toothpaste tubes/ toothbrush

Sanitary wastes, napkins, used tissue paper

Ballpens, marking pens

Used rags/gloves/paint brush

Broken glass/ceramics Cigarette butts









RECYCLABLE

(Except used bond paper)

Aluminum/tin cans/containers

Hard plastics (mineral/juice bottles)

Glass bottles

Used cardboards/folders/ envelopes, old newspaper/ magazines/brochures




USED BOND PAPER

Paper (dry, printed on both sides)








