Meeting 1 16 March 2016

Matters Discussed:

- Proposed 2016 Internal Audit Department (IAD) Work Plan. The NPBAC discussed the details of the proposed projects of IAD's two divisions, and approved the proposed Work Plan.
- 2. <u>Audit Report on the Review of Implementation Audit of Power Supply Agreement Eastern Mindanao Operations Division of the Small Power Utilities Group.</u> The NPBAC, after being apprised of the results of the audit, gave the following instructions to IAD:
 - require concerned groups to include a detailed timeline of actions that they commit
 to undertake to address audit findings, and monitor their compliance within six
 months; and
 - follow-up and monitor the progress of the drafting of the new Manual of Approvals.
- 3. <u>Filling-up of IAD Vacant positions</u>. The NPBAC directed IAD to present to it the results of evaluation by the Nomination and Remuneration Committee of applicants for IAD positions prior to endorsement to the Board for approval.

Matters Discussed:

- 1. <u>Job Levelling.</u> The NPBAC deliberated on and approved the proposed IAD job levelling.
- Report on Monitoring of Actions Taken on IAD Findings/Observations. The NPBAC directed IAD to conduct follow-up activities on pending non-compliances by concerned groups, who should be required to submit justifications for such non-compliances and timelines for compliance.

Matters Discussed:

- 1. Review of Asset Disposal System. The NPBAC considered the findings/observations reported, and instructed IAD to:
 - recommend that Management explore the possibility of requesting COA to assess the assets of the Bataan Nuclear Power Plant; and
 - · elevate the issue on BNPP to the Board.
- Review of Release of Funding Requirements Operations and Maintenance Agreement, Mindanao Generation. The NPBAC discussed the results of the IAD review and recommended that the Boards of NPC and Power Sector Assets and Liabilities Management Corporation (PSALM) convene in a joint meeting to thresh out the issues.
- 3. Review of Utility Plants Small Power Utilities Group (SPUG) Mindanao. After deliberation, the NPBAC set the yearend as deadline for Management to issue a policy for the deactivation and decommissioning of generating set units.
- 4. <u>Filling-up of Remaining IAD Vacancy</u>. The NPBAC approved the filling up of the remaining vacancy in IAD. It directed IAD to submit a request for the Nomination and Remuneration Committee to facilitate the selection process and submit its recommendation directly to the Board.
