2. Results of IAD Audit Projects.

Based on the discussions, the NPBAC gave instructions for Management to provide the Committee with a timeline of activities, status, and identity of the responsible persons/groups on the updating/revision of the Work Order Manual.

To further improve the timeliness of Universal Charge – Missionary Electrification (UCME) fund transfers from the Power Sector Assets and Liabilities Management Corporation (PSALM), the NPBAC instructed IAD to monitor Management's submission of requirements.

As to the installation of telecommunication facilities by Globe and Smart Telecommunications inside the Angat Rainforest and Ecological Park (AREP), the NPBAC required Management to update the NP Board on the status of the negotiation with the telecommunication companies.
